GENERAL COMMENTS:

The purpose of the annual inspection of Munoz Logging & Construction is to identify the fugitive dust generating activities and assess whether the control measures identified in the Compliance Plan Permit are in use and adequate to control fugitive dust emissions. The current Compliance Plan Permit is in effect until July 17, 2011.

STAFF REVIEW:

On August 10, 2010 staff inspected Munoz Logging & Construction located on Rand Road and discussed operations with Angel Munoz.

Topsoil is stockpiled at Munoz Logging & Construction located at 1540 Rand Road. One topsoil stockpile is located north of the building and the other topsoil stockpile is located on the east side of the building. Both stockpiles are covered in vegetation. The driveway and area around the building have gravel surfaces and are in good condition.

Mr. Munoz indicated that he does not expect any new topsoil to be hauled into the site and the area receives very little traffic. Mr. Munoz does not anticipate any major changes in operations and indicated that the stockpiles may eventually be leveled out.

SUMMARY:

It is staff's opinion that Munoz Logging & Construction is in conformity with the existing Compliance Plan Permit.
