SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRAITION NO. 9 FOR 2000

- 1. Weed & Seed Grant. \$9,051 of the total \$125,000 Department of Justice Grant. Grant includes one FTE and requires no City match. Remainder of grant will be appropriated to the 2001 budget.
- 2. Public Transportation. \$6,000 for power washer for washing buses. Federal funds \$4,800 plus \$1,200 from undesignated fund balance.
- 3. Parks. \$4,175 from Council Contingency to assist Wilson School PTA to purchase a play structure.
- 4. Construction Service Center. \$15,600 for a professional service agreement with GeoAnalytics for modernization of the City's Land Management & Permit Tracking System. Paid from building permit fees.
- 5. Fire Department. \$14,350 from the County for water recovery/rescue in accordance with the Year 2000 Intergovernmental Agreement.
- 6. Police Grants. \$70,000 form 1999 Juvenile Accountability Grant and \$28,736 from the 2000 Juvenile Accountability Grant. Federal funds only, as match will be provided by other agencies benefiting from the grants. Another \$69,536 of the 2000 Grant will be appropriated to the 2001 budget.
- 7. Hazardous Materials. \$30,907 including \$19,030 from the County in accordance with the Year 2000 Intergovernmental Agreement. The remainder is from undesignated cash to bring the City's appropriation to the agreed upon amount (\$26,530 of which only \$14,653 was previously budgeted).
- 8. Mayor/Council Contingency. (\$4,175). See Item 3 above.
