Re: Application to Conduct Raffle (City Ordinance 5.20.020)

The raffle is scheduled to begin on or about February 28, 2001, or upon notification of approval from your office. The raffle will terminate and drawing be held not later than thirty (30) days after the date we begin selling tickets.


Funds earned from the raffle will be used to fund our upcoming Tschetter Lecture and our general community involvement activities. No individual directly or indirectly will personally benefit from the raffle ticket proceeds.

NAU-SALA holds a quarterly lecture series in honor of the late Bill Tschetter, founder of the National American University Paralegal Studies Program. Each year we bring a speaker to lecture on a law related topic. The most recent past speakers include Frank Pommershiem, professor of Indian Law at USD and The Honorable David Gilbertson, South Dakota Supreme Court Justice. Invitations are sent to tribal, state, city and federal attorneys, justices, and judges and members of the public are invited to attend at no charge.

Past community involvement projects include monetary donations to the "Angels" project to purchase Christmas gifts for needy children and a food drive for WAVI and Ohitika Najin Win Oti women's shelters in Rapid City.
