The Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) Program would like to request a raffle permit.

The CASA Program is a non-profit 501(c) 3 agency that recruits, trains, and supervises community volunteers to advocate for abused and neglected children in court. Since we are an independent organization, partially funded through the United Way, we must seek financial contributions through various civic organizations and community support. In order to continue to meet the expanding needs of our program, we are planning on conducting our 9th annual playhouse fundraiser. We will be raffling off a child's playhouse as we did last year.
