Summary continued -

Each of the three choirs (Cadet, Camerata and Concert) experienced a substantial growth in numbers this season. It has been rewarding to hear a definite maturity in the Concert Choir. We expect this trend to continue.

Upon the resignation of our long-time colleague, Rebecca Kenner, a search for a replacement resulted in hiring Dara Baum, a Middle school choral director and a parent of a current chorus member.

Because of the ambitious performance schedule and tours over the past two years, the CHORUS will not be as active during this coming season. We will conceptrate on the Winter and Spring Concerts and are hoping that Dr. John Leavitt will be a guest conductor at one of them. Parents and choristers will be expecting to do a great deal of fund-raising as the Concert Choir looks forward to the Pacific Rim Children's Festival in Honolulu, July 2002. Our Chorus was one of seven children's choirs to be selected to this 10 day festival.

To develop the Chorus, we feel it is important to aid our directors by attendance at quality workshops. To that end, the Concert and Camerata directors will be attending a conference for children's choir directors at the American Boy Choir School in Princeton, N.J. in Spet.

The staff is continually looking at ways to enhance the choral skills of our choirs, but also in extending this opportunity to as many students as possible in the Black Hills area. Hopefully, we are able to continue offering this opportunity to students from Hill City, Piedmont, Hermosa, Ellsworth AFB and even to Wall.

Scholarships are always given to families whose budgets do not include many "extras." Even then, payment plans are arranged. In lieu of financial payment, we request donation of time, but do NOT require it. Speaking engagements at various civic organizations have resulted in providing additional scholarships.
