SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION NO. 5 FOR 2001

1. Urban Planning - \$22,544. Hire additional administrative secretary. Funds from Council Contingency. (Council 4/16).

2. Transportation Planning - \$70,000. Traffic Model Update. Funding \$57,365 from Federal Highway Administration Planning Funds with \$12,635 match from Council Contingency. (Council 2/19).

3. Historic Preservation - \$3,914. Reappropriate unexpended donations from previous years. From undesignated cash balance.

4. Weed & Seed - \$106,688 from second year grant funding plus \$50,000 from Federal asset forfeiture funds. Forfeiture funds designated toward Mobile Surveillance Platform being purchased by Police Department. Funded by Federal funds. No City match required.

5. 2012 Infrastructure Improvements – (\$1,200,000). To redesignate funding for economic development projects. (Council 3/5).

6. 2012 Economic Development - \$1,200,000. See item 5.

7. Community Development - \$0-. To reallocate funding between line items in accordance with approved grant.

8. Police Department - \$5,640. To appropriate proceeds from sale of scrap gunds toward purchase of new weapons.

9. Building Inspection - \$763. To appropriate funds for Uniform Mechanical Code Seminar from funds collected for that purpose.

10. Law Enforcement Block Grant 2000 - \$73,538. To appropriate remainder of Federal funds available from this grant. No additional City funds required.

11. Mayor, Council - \$10,540. To appropriate \$1,060 refund for conference not attended by Mayor Shaw, plus \$9,480 from Council Contingency for World War II Memorial (\$5,000 – Council 3/19), \$1,980 for high speed Internet access for Mayor and Council (Council 2/19) and \$2,500 to increase funding for fireworks display (Council 5/7).

12. Mayor, Council Contingency – (\$56,659). Items 1, 2, 11,13 and 14.

13. C/SAC Building - \$8,000. Includes \$6,500 for remodeling mailroom to provide an office for Community Development (Council 3/19) and \$1,500 for structural analysis of C/SAC Building (Council 5/7). Both from Council Contingency.

14. Dahl Fine Arts - \$4,000. Appraisal of MDU facility to be used for expansion of the Dahl Center. (Council 2/19)
