AN AGREEMENT TO EXCHANGE FEDERAL FOR STATE FUNDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF PROJECT P 1746(00) PCEMS 4530 IN RAPID CITY, SOUTH DAKOTA (CANYON LAKE DR. FROM SOO SAN DR. TO DAKOTA DR.)

This **AGREEMENT** is made by and between the South Dakota Department of Transportation, hereinafter referred to as "**STATE**" and the City of Rapid City hereinafter referred to as "**CITY**".

WHEREAS, both parties to this AGREEMENT desire that project P 1746(00), PCEMS 4530 (Canyon Lake Dr. from Soo San Dr. to Dakota Dr.), be let for construction in FY2003 and shall be hereinafter referred to as "PROJECT";

AND WHEREAS it is in the best interest to let **PROJECT** as a state project thus eliminating certain federal requirements resulting in significant anticipated cost savings;

AND WHEREAS PROJECT costs include preliminary engineering, materials, right of way, construction, and construction engineering with a total estimated at \$2,100,000.

AND WHEREAS this **AGREEMENT** supersedes and voids Agreement number 612799.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties to this AGREEMENT agree as follows:

- **A. STATE** will perform the following activities:
 - STATE will provide technical assistance for PROJECT, approve plans and specifications prior to advertising for letting, and concur in CITY award of contract to the lowest responsible bidder.
 - 2. STATE will exchange CITY STP funds for STATE funds at a ratio of 90:10 to fund 81.95% of PROJECT. With the exchange, PROJECT cost split will be 91.05555% CITY STP funds and the remainder will be STATE match.

- 3. STATE agrees to reimburse CITY for eligible PROJECT costs with funds as described in section A.2 upon receipt of proper documentation of work completed, services performed, or supplies furnished.
- 4. The Local Government Assistance Engineer or his designee will be invited to the final inspection of PROJECT and may choose to attend.
- **B. CITY** will perform the following:
 - CITY agrees to transfer CITY STP funds to STATE balance of STP funds at a ratio of 90:10 to fund 81.95% of PROJECT costs as per section A.2.
 - 2. CITY will develop plans, specifications, bid documents, advertise for bids, and award contract to the lowest responsible bidder upon concurrence by the Local Government Assistance Engineer.
 - 3. CITY will arrange for all utility adjustments and right of way prior to construction.
 - 4. CITY agrees to provide construction administration for PROJECT.
 - **5. CITY** agrees to make progress payments for **PROJECT** and then seek reimbursement from the **STATE**.
 - **6. CITY** agrees to pay for non-participating utility work directly, using **CITY** funds.
- C. This **AGREEMENT** is binding upon signatories hereto not as individuals but solely in their capacities as officials of their respective organizations and acknowledges proper action of **STATE** and **CITY** to enter into the same.
