Sam.

Copperfield residents are charged the exact same as any other resident of Rapid Valley, as I was informed.

Water: \$9.95 for the first 1,000 gallons plus \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons thereafter. This would make the average residential bill about \$22.00 per month assuming they use 7,000 gallons of water.

Sewer: \$10.70 for the first 1,000 gallons of water usage plus \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons thereafter.

NOTE: Sewer usage is based on the average of the water meter readings taken in January and February and March. This is normally around 7,000 gallons. At this rate the monthly sewer bill would be about \$23.00

Comparing that to the normal Rapid City Resident the monthly bills would be:

Water: \$7.90 for the first 2 units (1,500 gallons) plus \$1.40 per gallon thereafter. This would make the average residential bull about \$19.00 per month.

Sewer: \$4.00 minimum charge per residential connection plus \$1.48 per unit (750 gallons) thereafter. This is based on the water meter readings taken in January, February and March. This is normally about 10 units or 7,500 gallons. This would make the average monthly bill about \$19.00.

John, correct me if I am giving Sam the wrong information.
