National Stats:

- United States is 4.5% of the world's population and consumes 51% of the world's illegal drugs.
- The number one place where youth use drugs is at a friend's house.
The number two place is at their own home.
- 1 out of 4 kids is Bullied.
- 8% of students miss 1 day of class per month for fear of bullies.

Local Stats:

- 40% of high school students use tobacco
- 14% of 7th graders, 46% of 9th graders, and 55% of 11th graders have used alcohol one or more times in the last month.
- 10% of Middle School Students say they feel sad or depressed most of the time while 18% of Middle School students say they are not sure.
- 28% of High School students say they feel sad or depressed most of the time.

At 9 years old, Chuck Peterson did not care what others thought of him. When Chuck began experimenting with drugs, alcohol, and sex at the age of 14, that all changed. The choices he made during those teen years placed him on a destructive path that almost destroyed his life. Today Chuck Peterson, of Burnsville, MN, speaks to young people across the Midwest confronting the issues they face. He tells stories of his own life: the struggles with his parents, drugs, becoming a teenage dad, and almost losing his wife and kids due to alcohol abuse. Chuck shares in a humorous, honest and uplifting way, which captures the attention of young and old alike. He encourages them with hope for a good future, and to live a life that is Alive & Well!
