SUBJECT: Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) Training

I am requesting that Officer Chad Strobel and myself be allowed to attend the Advanced Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design course scheduled for August 23-25, 2004. Timothy D. Crowe, who has over 25 years of experience as a criminologist and has dealt with numerous agencies in the crime prevention and loss prevention field, instructs the course. This class will take place at the Galt House Hotel in Louisville, KY.

Currently Sergeant Fred Eisenbraun, who is scheduled to retire at the end of May 2004, is the only officer with the Rapid City Police Department who is certified in the CPTED field. He has suggested that we attend only the Advanced CPTED course as he did and the course only requires some experience with CPTED concepts. This will also save the City of Rapid City about \$2214.00 in registration fees, lodging and meals for not attending the basic CPTED course.

This course will be of great benefit to the department and community at large. It will give great insight into ways the community can make changes that deter criminal acts from taking place. It gives an alternative to active patrols and other direct contact methods for a community to employ that can have an impact on criminal activity.
