The question was raised, at the Public Works Meeting, on Tuesday 10 May 2005, in reference to Lind-Exco, Inc.'s request for variances on two driveways, as to the width of driveways in the neighborhood, and if any of our neighbors would have any objection to Lind-Exco, Inc. having 40 foot wide driveways.

I went out to the neighborhood, and reviewed the existing commercial/industrial driveways. The following table provides the information observed:

I have talked with the owner's of approaches 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 10, 14, 15, 16, and 17, and these owners support the installation of a 40 Foot approach at Lind-Exco, Inc.'s shop. Additionally, these owners all had anecdotal information on catastrophic events involving vehicle damage, lost goods, and even a hazardous materials spill, causally related to insufficient approach width, along Dyess Avenue.
