RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Variance to the Subdivision Regulations to waive the requirements to install curb, gutter, sidewalk, street light conduit, water and sewer along Radar Hill Road as per Chapter 16.16 of the Rapid City Municipal Code be approved with the following stipulation:

1. Prior to City Council approval, the applicant shall sign a waiver of right to protest any future assessments for the improvements.

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GENERAL COMMENTS:

The applicant has submitted a Variance to the Subdivision Regulations to waive the requirement to install curb, gutter, sidewalk, street light conduit, water and sewer along Radar Hill Road as it abuts the subject property. In addition, the applicant has submitted a Layout Plat to subdivide the subject property into a 2.25 acre lot leaving a 17.75 acre non-transferable unplatted balance. (See companion item #05PL030.)

The subject property is located in the southwest corner of the Long view Road/Radar Hill Road intersection and is currently void of any structural development.

STAFF REVIEW:

Staff has reviewed the Variance to the Subdivision Regulations and has noted the following considerations:

Street Improvements: Radar Hill Road is located along the east lot line of the subject property and is classified as a principal arterial street on the City's Major Street Plan. A principal arterial street must be located in a minimum 100 foot wide right-of-way and constructed with a minimum 40 foot wide paved surface with curb, gutter, street light conduit, sidewalk, water and sewer. Currently, Radar Hill Road is located in a 66 foot wide right-of-way with a 24 foot wide paved surface. Currently, curb, gutter, sidewalk, street light conduit, water and sewer do not exist along this section of Radar Hill Road. Requiring the improvement of Radar Hill Road as it abuts the subject property will result in a discontinuous street section. As such, staff is recommending that the Variance to the Subdivision Regulations to waive the improvements along Radar Hill Road be approved with the stipulation that the applicant sign a waiver of right to protest any future assessment for the improvement.

<u>Legal Notification Requirement</u>: The receipts from the certified mailings have not been returned. Staff will notify the Planning Commission at the March 10, 2005 Planning Commission meeting if this requirement is not met. Staff has not received any calls or inquires regarding this proposal
