Schedule of Benefits on page 2 in your Benefit Book.

Office Visits
(Includes Chiropractic Care)

\$20 co-pay per visit, then subject to deductible and coinsurance. X-ray and lab charges are not subject to the \$20 co-pay. Deductible waived for office surgical procedures if surgery meets criteria set forth in Section 4.51.

The following text replaces S4.51 "Outpatient Surgery" located
on page 21 in your Benefit Book.

S4.51 OUTPATIENT SURGERY

Surgeries that meet the following criteria are not subject to deductible:

- A. Surgery must be performed on an outpatient basis. "Outpatient" is defined as a total time at the facility not to exceed 23 hours and the charge for such service is less than an overnight charge in the same care facility.
- B. This benefit will not apply if complications from the outpatient surgery procedure require extended hospital care. "Extended hospital care" shall mean the patient was admitted to an overnight care facility or the patient stay was extended for more than 23 hours at the outpatient care facility.

(Please note: Care exceeding 23 hours will be considered an inpatient admission and must be pre-certified. See Article III of this Plan for proper direction in obtaining pre-certification.)

The following text replaces the definition of
"Surgical Procedure" in
Article IX located on page 41 in your Benefit Book.

SURGICAL PROCEDURE

A surgical procedure means a manual or operative procedure to a major body cavity or structure for correction of deformities and defects, repair of injuries, and/or diagnosis and cure of medical conditions. Includes superficial structures of the body or a manipulative procedure requiring anesthetic.
