PERMANENT OVERHEAD UTILITY EASEMENT

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, CITY OF RAPID CITY, a municipal corporation, of 300 Sixth Street, Rapid City, South Dakota, 57701, Grantor, hereby grants to all public utilities a permanent utility easement over the following described real property:

A portion of the vacated alley adjacent to Lots One (1) through Five (5) and Lots Twenty-eight (28) through Thirty-two (32) of Block 103, Original Town of Rapid City, located in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼NW¼) of Section One (1), Township One North (T1N), Range Seven East (R7E) of the Black Hills Meridian, Rapid City, Pennington County, South Dakota, as shown on Exhibit "A", which has been attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

This easement grants to all public utilities the right to enter onto the easement property to construct, operate, maintain, alter, remove, upgrade, enhance, and replace an electrical power system consisting of overhead lines or wires, electrical power line with poles and associated equipment, and all necessary attachments and appurtenant facilities. Any facilities that are installed in this easement must have a minimum clearance of fourteen and a half feet between the bottom of the lowest line and the roof of any structures. Prior to the installation of any facilities,



the public utility shall contact the City at least a week in advance and inform them of the scope and location of the work contemplated. All work shall be performed in a workman like manner. Any damage to property or injury to persons caused by the utility in the construction, maintenance or operation of facilities within this easement is the responsibility of the public utility and by using the easement such public utility specifically consents to such liability.
