RE: Authorization for Mayor and Finance Officer to sign a waiver of right to protest a future assessment for street improvements.

Legal Description: A portion of Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, located in the NW1/4 SW1/4 of Section 17, T1N, R8E, BHM, Rapid City, Pennington County, South Dakota, as shown on the plat recorded July 10, 1997 and recorded in Book 28 of Plats on Page 27, more fully described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, said corner being marked by a rebar with survey cap "RW FISK 6565"; thence, northerly along the westerly edge of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision and along the easterly edge of Highway 79 right-of-way, N00°01'09"W, a distance of 225.01 feet more or less, to an angle point of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, said corner being marked by a rebar with survey cap "LS4208" and said corner being coincident with the southwesterly corner of Lot B of Biernbaum Subdivision, as shown on the plat recorded July 10, 1997 and recorded in Book 28 of Plats on Page 27; thence, easterly along the northerly edge of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision and along the southerly edge of Lot B of Biernbaum Subdivision, N89°51'25"E, a distance of 206.31 feet more or less, to a point on the westerly edge of Amended Lot H2 of Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, as shown in the plat filed April 8, 2003 and recorded in Book 10 of Highway Plats on Page 111, said point being marked by a rebar with survey cap "LS 6119"; thence, southerly along the westerly edge of said Amended Lot H2 of Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, S00°05'02"W, a distance of 225.68 feet more or less, to the south line of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, also being the southwest corner of said Amended Lot H2 of Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, said corner being marked by a "SDDOT Monument"; thence, westerly along the southerly line of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision,

N89°57'30"W, a distance of 205.90 feet more or less, to the point of beginning.

A Variance to the Subdivision Regulations to waive the requirement to install curb, gutter, street light conduit, additional pavement or additional extension of water or sewer main in any adjoining right-of-way, and the requirement to dedicate additional right-of-way has been submitted in conjunction with a Preliminary Plat to plat one lot. A stipulation of approval of the Variance to the Subdivision Regulations requires that the applicant sign a waiver of right to protest any future assesment for the improvements. The document also requires the signature of the Mayor and the Finance Officer.

**Staff Recommendation: Authorize the Mayor and Finance Officer to sign the waiver of right to protest a future assesment for the installation of curb, gutter, street light conduit, additional pavement or additional extension of water or sewer main as it abuts the above legally described property.**

AGREEMENT WAIVING RIGHT TO PROTEST  
(SDCL 9-45-26; 9-47-13; 9-48-18; 9-48-42)

THIS AGREEMENT IS MADE and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2007, by and for PACIFIC HIDE & FUR DEPOT, hereinafter called "Developer," and the City of Rapid City, a municipal corporation of the State of South Dakota, hereinafter called the "City."

WHEREAS the Developer has submitted a proposed subdivision plat; and

WHEREAS it is the intended purpose of the Developer to obtain final approval for this subdivision plat; and

WHEREAS the City of Rapid City's subdivision regulations require installation of curb, gutter, water, sewer, and street light conduit, which in this instance would require the Developer to install curb, gutter, sewer, and street light conduit on the east-west rearage road and improvements to curb, gutter, water, and street light conduit on the north-south rearage road as they abut a portion of Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, located in the NW1/4 SW1/4 of Section 17, T1N, R8E, BHM, Rapid City, Pennington County, South Dakota, as shown on the plat recorded July 10, 1997 and recorded in Book 28 of Plats on Page 27, more fully described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, said corner being marked by a rebar with survey cap "RW FISK 6565"; thence, northerly along the westerly edge of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision and along the easterly edge of Highway 79 right-of-way, N00°01'09"W, a distance of 225.01 feet more or less, to an angle point of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, said corner being marked by a rebar with survey cap "LS4208" and said corner being coincident with the southwest corner of Lot B of Biernbaum Subdivision, as shown on the plat recorded July 10, 1997 and recorded in Book 28 of Plats on Page 27; thence, easterly along the northerly edge of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision and along the southerly edge of Lot B of Biernbaum Subdivision, N89°51'25"E, a distance of 206.31 feet more or less, to a point on the westerly edge of Amended Lot H2 of Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, as shown in the plat filed April 8, 2003 and recorded in Book 10 of Highway Plats on Page 111, said point being marked by a rebar with survey cap "LS 6119"; thence, southerly along the westerly edge of said Amended Lot H2 of Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, S00°05'02"W, a distance of 225.68

feet more or less, to the south line of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, also being the southwest corner of said Amended Lot H2 of Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, said corner being marked by a "SDDOT Monument"; thence, westerly along the southerly line of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, N89°57'30"W, a distance of 205.90 feet more or less, to the point of beginning; and

WHEREAS it is the intent and purpose of both the Developer and the City to enter into an agreement whereby the Developer will consent to a future assessed project for the installation of curb, gutter, sewer, and street light conduit on the east-west rearage road and improvements to curb, gutter, water, and street light conduit on the north-south rearage road as they abut the subject property in exchange for the City not requiring immediate installation of the improvements as required by Rapid City Subdivision Regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions contained herein, it is hereby agreed as follows:

1. This agreement pertains to, and includes those properties which are designated and identified as follows:

A portion of Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, located in the NW1/4 SW1/4 of Section 17, T1N, R8E, BHM, Rapid City, Pennington County, South Dakota, as shown on the plat recorded July 10, 1997 and recorded in Book 28 of Plats on Page 27, more fully described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, said corner being marked by a rebar with survey cap "RW FISK 6565"; thence, northerly along the westerly edge of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision and along the easterly edge of Highway 79 right-of-way, N00°01'09"W, a distance of 225.01 feet more or less, to an angle point of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, said corner being marked by a rebar with survey cap "LS4208" and said corner being coincident with the southwesterly corner of Lot B of Biernbaum Subdivision, as shown on the plat recorded July 10, 1997 and recorded in Book 28 of Plats on Page 27; thence, easterly along the northerly edge of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision and along the southerly edge of Lot B of Biernbaum Subdivision, N89°51'25"E, a distance of 206.31 feet more or less, to a point on the westerly edge of Amended Lot H2 of Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, as shown in the plat filed April 8, 2003 and recorded in Book 10 of Highway Plats on Page 111, said point being marked by a rebar with survey cap "LS 6119"; thence, southerly along the westerly edge of said Amended Lot H2 of Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, S00°05'02"W, a distance of 225.68 feet more or less, to the south line of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, also being the southwest corner of said Amended Lot H2 of Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, said corner being marked by a "SDDOT Monument"; thence, westerly along the southerly line of said Lot A of Biernbaum Subdivision, N89°57'30"W, a distance of 205.90 feet more or less, to the point of beginning.

2. This agreement specifically references the installation of curb, gutter, sewer, and street light conduit on the east-west rearage road and improvements to curb, gutter, water, and street light conduit on the north-south rearage road as they abut the subject property.

3. The Developer acknowledges the City has the power to make assessments for local improvements on property adjoining or benefited thereby, to collect same in the manner provided by law, and to fix, determine and collect penalties for nonpayment of any special assessments. The Developer agrees that if at any time in the future the City determines it is necessary or desirous to install curb, gutter, sewer, and street light conduit on the east-west rearage road and improvements to curb, gutter, water, and street light conduit on the north-south rearage road as they abut the subject property through an assessed project, Developer or its heirs, assigns, or successors in interest, waive any right to object to such an assessed project as allowed under state law in consideration for the final approval of the subdivision plat without the immediate installation of curb, gutter, water, sewer, and street light conduit. It is understood by the Developer that the City of Rapid City's primary consideration for the granting of the approval for a subdivision plat on the herein described property and forbearance from requiring Developer to immediately install curb, gutter, sewer, and street light conduit on the east-west rearage road and improvements to curb, gutter, water, and street light conduit on the north-south rearage road is the Developer's covenant and promise to waive any right to object to the assessed project and its consent to the assessed project.

4. Developer further covenants and agrees for itself, its heirs, assigns, and successors in interest, that should it or any of its heirs, assigns, or successors in interest fail to abide by each and every covenant herein contained, the immediate installation of curb, gutter, sewer, and street light conduit on the east-west rearage road and improvements to curb, gutter, water, and street light conduit on the north-south rearage road as they abut the subject property, which is required in the City subdivision regulations, will be required within 90 days of the objection in order to comply with the City of Rapid City's subdivision regulations. Should the weather prevent immediate installation of these subdivision improvements, the City Council may accept a surety bond in an amount equal to the estimated cost of installation of the improvements, whereby the improvements will be made and utilities installed without cost to the City in the event of default of the Developer.

5. All of the terms and conditions herein set forth shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, assigns, or successors in interest of the Developer, and be considered as a covenant running with the above-described property. Furthermore, it is agreed that, in accepting title to the above-described property any grantee, heir, assign, or successor in interest to the undersigned expressly agrees to be bound by the terms of this agreement recorded with the Pennington County Register of Deeds' Office pursuant to the provisions of South Dakota statutes.

6. The City may undertake any legal or equitable action available to enforce the provisions of this agreement in addition to any remedy provided herein. In the event the City is required to undertake any action to enforce the terms of this agreement or its subdivision regulations in connection with this agreement, the undersigned, heirs, assigns or successors in interest agree the

City may recover from the owner of said property its reasonable expenses, including attorney's fees incurred with respect to such action.

7. If any section(s), or provision of this application is declared invalid for any reason whatsoever by any competent court, such invalidity shall not affect any other section(s) or provision of this application if they can be given effect without the invalid section(s) or provisions.

8. This agreement shall be construed according to the laws of the State of South Dakota. No modification or amendment to this agreement shall be valid, unless evidenced by a writing signed by the parties hereto.

9. If the Developer is a corporation, it has the power to enter into this agreement and its officers signing for it have full power and authority to do so.


