- 1. Conduct study of need for annexation
- 2. Submittal for Planning Commission
- 3. Notice of Hearing and Resolution of Intent to Annex sent certified mail to property owners and Board of County Commissioners
- 4. Planning Commission considers Resolution of Intent to Annex (provisions of 9-4-4.2 included in resolution)
- 5. Legal and Finance Committee considers Resolution of Intent to Annex
- 6. Submittal to City Council
- 7. City Council considers/adopts Resolution of Intent to Annex
- 8. Notice of Annexation Hearing and Adopted Resolution of Intent sent certified mail to Property owners and Board of County Commissioners
- 9. Submittal for Planning Commission
- 10. Submittal for County Commission
- 11. Board of County Commissioners considers/approves Resolution of Annexation (if unplatted lands are included in annexation area). The Resolution must contain description and boundaries of territory to be annexed pursuant to SDCL 9-19.
- 12. Planning Commission considers Resolution of Annexation
- 13. Legal and Finance Committee considers Resolution of Annexation
- 14. Submittal for City Council

- 15. Within 60 days of adoption of the Resolution of Intent the City Council holds public hearing and considers/adopts Resolution of Annexation. (If Such adoption does not occur at this time then it must occur within 120 days of the public hearing).
- 16. Annexation Resolution and map filed with Register of Deeds (20 days after publication)
- 17. Annexation Resolution and map are recorded by the Register of Deeds and annexation becomes effective immediately after recordation.
