## RECOMMENDATION:

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Staff recommends that the Vacation of Easement be approved.

<u>GENERAL COMMENTS</u>: (Update: October 15, 2008. All revised and/or added text is shown in bold.) This item was continued at the October 9, 2008 Planning Commission meeting because the required revised site plan had not been obtained. In addition, the required Exceptions had not been obtained. On October 6, 2008 the applicant submitted a revised site plan that was reviewed by staff. In addition, staff approved an Exception to a driveway width of 32 feet in lieu of the allowed 20 feet. As such, staff recommends that the Vacation of a Portion of a Non-Access Easement be approved.

The property is located at the northeast corner of Elm Avenue and Field View Drive. The property is zoned Low Density Residential. The adjacent properties to the north, south, east, and west are zoned Low Density Residential. A single family dwelling is currently being constructed on the property. The applicant is proposing to vacate a portion of a Non-Access Easement along Field View Drive.

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<u>STAFF REVIEW</u>: Staff has reviewed the Vacation of a Portion of Non-Access Easement and has noted the following considerations:

## Site Plan:

The site plan that was submitted for this project did not include the structures that are currently on the property. In order for staff to make a complete review of this request the applicant must submit a complete site plan that includes the location of structures currently on the property. In addition the applicant must show the exact portion of the Non-Access Easement that is proposed to be vacated. On October 6, 2008 the applicant submitted a revised site plan. The plan was reviewed and approved by staff. As such, staff recommends that the Vacation of a Portion of a Non-Access Easement be approved.

<u>Driveway Width</u>: The Rapid City Street Design Criteria Manual Section 8.2.1A states that residential driveways shall be no more than 20 feet in width. Any residential driveway over 20 feet in width requires an Exception to the Rapid City Street Design Criteria Manual. The applicant is proposing to vacate a portion of a Non-Access easement along Field View Drive in order to build a driveway. Without a complete site plan, staff is unable to determine the exact width of the proposed driveway. **On October 6, 2008 the applicant obtained an Exception to allow a 32 foot wide driveway in lieu of the allowed 20 feet. As such, staff recommends that the Vacation of a Portion of a Non-Access Easement be approved.** 

<u>Curb Cut Width</u>: The Rapid City Street Design Criteria Manual Section 8.2.1H states that the total width of all curb cuts for any ownership on a street shall not exceed fifty percent of the frontage of the ownership along the street. Any curb cut exceeding fifty percent of the frontage of the ownership along the street requires an Exception to the Rapid City Street Design Criteria Manual. Without a complete site plan staff is unable to determine the curb cut width of the proposed driveway. On October 6, 2008 the applicant submitted a revised site plan drawn to scale identifying a curb cut not exceeding fifty percent of the frontage of the ownership along the street. As such, staff recommends that the Vacation of a Portion of a Non-Access Easement be approved.

<u>Corner Clearance</u>: The Rapid City Street Design Criteria Manual Section 8.2.3 states that at locations where the required corner clearance cannot be attained, a minimum corner clearance of fifty feet shall be maintained. Any corner clearance that is less than 50 feet requires an Exception to the Rapid City Street Design Criteria Manual. Without a complete site plan staff is unable to determine the corner clearance of the proposed driveway. On October 6, 2008 the applicant submitted a revised site plan drawn to scale identifying a corner clearance of more than 50 feet. As such, staff recommends that the Vacation of a Portion of a Non-Access Easement be approved.
