Mayor & Jim – please review and let me know if it is ok to send as it is on the LF agenda today. Kay

Sam — if you look at the travel request for the Mayor/Council Office — it includes the registration fee for all attendees — that amount is NOT paid for from the Mayor/Council budget — only the 3 Aldermen --\$30 each-or \$90 - the rest will be charged out to the individual departments attending — this way one registration check is cut to the League and it doesn't get doubled up.

The 3 aldermen (Olson, LaCroix, Kooiker) are staying one night in Pierre plus transportation costs for the 3 Aldermen – dinner and lunch are included in the registration fee. The thing to remember is that this is only an estimated amount and in fact, the travel request form states "estimated cost" <u>– it cannot go over the estimated amount without coming back to Council</u> if the total for everyone attending is more than \$1500. The hotel costs may come in lower for whatever reason or perhaps someone decides not to charge for transportation, those things can make a difference in the actual cost of the trip. We have to include transportation costs individually for Council members as normally they do not take a city vehicle as Finance or some other department may and since most Aldermen's schedules are different, they normally choose to travel separately.

I will however check with Katie to see why she included a meal cost for \$62 on the one for the Council and think that can be lowered as we should only be paying for breakfast for the three aldermen attending.

As to costs for the others, I can't answer that and will defer to Mr. Preston.
