## AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF RAPID CITY AND SSST, LLC FOR THE COMPLETION OF SUBDIVISION IMPROVEMENTS SECURED BY BOND NUMBER 105245299

This agreement is made and entered into by and between the City of Rapid City, located at 300 Sixth Street, Rapid City, SD 57701, hereinafter referred to as "City," and SSST, LLC, located at PO Box 1940, Rapid City, SD 57709-1940, hereinafter referred to as "Developer."

WHEREAS, the Developer is seeking approval of a final plat for property legally described as:

WHEREAS, the Developer has submitted a subdivision bond (Bond Number 105245299 in the amount of \$582,002.81) to secure the completion of subdivision improvements as required by the City's subdivision regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City is requesting that the Developer provide a date by which the required improvements will be completed, or if they are not, the City may draw on the bond; and

WHEREAS, the Developer is willing to provide a final date for completion of the improvements so that the City will accept the bond which is a requirement for approval of the final plat.

## NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. This Agreement pertains to Bond Number 105245299 issued by Travelers Casualty and Surety Company of America.
- 2. The Developer agrees to complete the required subdivision improvements secured by the above bond by June 5, 2011.
- 3. If the required improvements are not completed by January 5, 2011, the parties agree that the City has the option, if it so chooses, to draw upon the above-referenced bond and complete the improvements. The City will notify the Developer prior to drawing on the bond and will provide the Developer with a reasonable amount of time to complete the remaining improvements.
- 4. In exchange for the Developer's agreement to the terms contained in paragraphs 1-3 of this document, the City agrees to accept the bond submitted by the Developer.
- 5. The parties' rights and obligations under this Agreement shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of South Dakota. Any dispute

concerning this Agreement shall be venued and litigated in the Circuit Court for the Seventh Judicial Circuit, located in Rapid City, Pennington County, South Dakota.
