We have been given the building at 603 Quincy St. to use as the site for two of our classes. We received authorization to use the building on Friday June 5th, 2009. The two classes are Urban Search and Rescue and Rapid Intervention Teams. Each class will have a maximum of 24 students.

We are requesting the following area to be utilized for the training event.
