

Scope of Services:

DDI will provide professional civil engineering services for the design and the preparation of all bidding documents for approximately 1,200 feet of sanitary sewer main extending along Easy Street located south of Coral Drive and west of Sheridan Lake Road. Construction administration services will be determined at a later date.

DDI will provide a design schedule to meet the City's construction schedule and will allow the City to tentatively open bids on the 15th day of December, 2009.

ARTICLE 1 ENGINEERING SERVICES

Method and means of compensation:

Payments to DDI will be on the basis of labor, reimbursable expenses and tax as defined in the attached FEE SCHEDULE. The fee is for the project components and is estimated not to exceed the following:

Services to be provided per the agreement and together with the following elements constitute the entire Agreement superseding any and all prior negotiations, correspondence, or agreements either written or oral. Any changes to this Agreement must be mutually agreed to in writing. The following attachments are incorporated:

ARTICLE 2 OWNER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

- 2.1 The Owner shall provide full information regarding requirements for the Project. The Owner shall furnish required information as expeditiously as necessary for the orderly progress of the Work, and the Engineer shall be entitled to rely on the accuracy and completeness thereof.
- 2.2 The Owner shall designate a representative authorized to act on the Owner's behalf with respect to the Project. The Owner or such authorized representative shall render decisions in a timely manner pertaining to documents submitted by the Engineer in order to avoid unreasonable delay in the orderly and sequential progress of the Engineer's services.

ARTICLE 3 USE OF ENGINEER'S DOCUMENTS

3.1 The documents prepared by the Engineer for this Project are instruments of the Engineer's service for use solely with respect to this Project and, unless otherwise provided, the Engineer shall be deemed the author of these documents and shall retain all common law, statutory and other reserved rights, including the copyright. The Owner shall be permitted to retain copies, including reproducible copies, of the Engineer's documents shall not be used by the Owner or others on other projects, for additions to this Project of for completion of this Project by others, unless the Engineer is adjudged to be in default under this Agreement, except by agreement in writing and with appropriate compensation to the Engineer.

ARTICLE 4 TERMINATION OR SUSPENSION

- **4.1** This Agreement may be terminated by either party upon not less than seven days' written notice in accordance with the terms of this Agreement through no fault of the party initiating the termination without cause.
- 4.2 If the Owner fails to make payment when due the Engineer for services and expenses, the Engineer may, upon seven days' written notice to the Owner, suspend performance of services under this Agreement. Unless payment in full is received by the Engineer within seven days of the date of the notice, the suspension shall take effect without further notice. In the event of a suspension of services, the Engineer shall have no liability to the Owner for delay or damage caused the Owner because of such suspension of services.
- **4.3** In the event of termination not the fault of the Engineer, the Engineer shall be compensated for services performed prior to termination, together with Reimbursable Expenses then due.

ARTICLE 5 MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

5.1 Unless otherwise provided, this Agreement shall be governed by the law of the State of South Dakota.

- 5.2 Causes of action between the parties to this Agreement pertaining to acts or failures to act shall be deemed to have accrued and the applicable statute of limitations shall commence to run not later than the date payment is due the Engineer pursuant to Section 7.4.
- 5.3 The Owner and Engineer, respectively, bind themselves, their partners, successors, assigns and legal representatives to the other party to this Agreement and to the partners, successors, assigns and legal representatives of such other party with respect to all covenants of this Agreement. Neither Owner nor Engineer shall assign this Agreement without the written consent of the other.
- 5.4 This Agreement and attachments as referenced represents the entire and integrated agreement between the Owner and Engineer and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations or agreements, either written or oral. This Agreement may be amended only by written instrument signed by both Owner and Engineer.
- 5.5 Nothing contained in this Agreement shall create a contractual relationship with or a cause of action in favor of a third party against either the Owner or Engineer.
- 5.6 Unless otherwise provided in this Agreement, the Engineer and Engineer's consultants shall have no responsibility for the discovery, presence, handling, removal or disposal of or exposure of persons to hazardous materials in any form at the Project site, including but not limited to asbestos, asbestos products, polychlorinated biphenyl (PCB) or other toxic substances.

ARTICLE 6 PAYMENTS TO THE ENGINEER 6.1 DIRECT PERSONNEL EXPENSE

6.1.1 Direct Personnel Expense is defined as the direct salaries of the Engineer's personnel engaged on the Project and the portion of the cost of their mandatory and customary contributions and benefits related thereto, such as employment taxes and other statutory employee benefits, insurance, sick leave, holidays, vacations, pension, and similar contributions and benefits.

6.2 REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES

- 6.2.1 Reimbursable Expenses are in addition to the Engineer's compensation and include expenses incurred by the Engineer and Engineer's employees and subconsultants in the interest of the Project for (See ATTACHMENT #3):
 - 1. Expenses of transportation and living expenses in connection with out-of-town travel authorized by the Owner;
 - 2. Long-distance communications;
 - 3. Fees paid for securing approval of authorities having jurisdiction over the Project;
 - 4. Reproductions;
 - 5. Postage and handling of documents;

- 6. Expense of additional coverage or limits, including professional liability insurance, requested by the Owner in excess of that normally carried by the Engineer and the Engineer's sub-consultants.
- 7. Engineering sub-consultants

6.3 PAYMENTS ON ACCOUNT OF THE ENGINEER'S SERVICES

- 6.3.1 Payments on account of the Engineer's services and for Reimbursable Expenses shall be made monthly upon presentation of the Engineer's statement of services rendered or as otherwise provided in this Agreement.
- **6.3.2** An initial payment as set forth in Section 7.1 is the minimum payment under this Agreement.

6.4 ENGINEER'S ACCOUNTING RECORDS

6.4.1 Records of Reimbursable Expenses and expenses pertaining to services performed on the basis of a multiple of Direct Personnel Expense shall be available to the Owner or the Owner's authorized representative at mutually convenient times.

ARTICLE 7 BASIS OF COMPENSATION

The Owner shall compensate the Engineer as follows:

- 7.1 AN INITIAL PAYMENT OF zero (\$0.00) shall be made upon execution of this Agreement and credited to the Owner's account at final payment.
- 7.2 COMPENSATION FOR THE ENGINEER'S SERVICES, as described in Article 1, Engineer's Services, shall be computed as follows:

For Design Services on an hourly basis not to exceed with hourly rates in accordance with the attached Fee Schedules with a not-to-exceed amount for Design of \$24,750.00 including Reimbursable expenses but not including taxes. The Maximum Limiting Fee is the aggregate of \$24,750.00 and is not limited per task. (See ATTACHMENTS 1, 2 and 3) The estimated fee breakdown is as follows:

INTRODUCTION

American Engineering Testing Inc. (AET) is pleased to provide this proposal for conducting a Geotechnical Study for the proposed Easy Street Sanitary Sewer Extension project in Rapid City, South Dakota. This proposal is based on the information provided and defines the general scope, completion schedule, and estimated costs for our work.

PROJECT INFORMATION

We understand the project will consist of the extension of the sanitary sewer along Easy Street from its intersection with Corral Drive southward for a length of approximately 1100 feet. We anticipate the alignment will run down the approximate center of the gravel surfaced street. At this time we understand the depth of the sewer will range from 8 to 10 feet.

We assume access to the potential drill holes will be possible with a truck mounted drill rig and support vehicle.

SCOPE OF WORK

The purpose of the geotechnical study will be to provide subsurface information along the alignment of the new sewer line to provide information and engineering recommendations for planning and design of the project. In order to accomplish the above stated purpose, AET proposes the following scope of work:

- 1. Drill four Standard Penetration Borings (SPT) borings along the approximate sewer line alignment to depths of 10 feet below existing grades.
- 2. The subsurface conditions will be logged at each location and groundwater levels taken at each boring location following drilling. The borings will be advanced using either 4.25" I.D. Hollow Stem Auger or 4-inch flight auger. Soil samples will be collected in accordance with the procedures outlined in ASTM D3550.
- 3. Perform a nominal amount of laboratory testing in accordance with the appropriate ASTM procedures to classify the soils in order to estimate the characteristic engineering and index properties, as well as strength properties of the soils. Lab testing will likely include natural moisture content, dry density and proctors.
- 4. Provide three (3) copies of a report summarizing the results of the field work, and laboratory data with engineering conclusions and recommendations regarding soil/bedrock profiles, groundwater levels, excavation and backfill.

The following is our initial proposal to complete Categorical Exclusion documentation for environmental assessment (EA) for the Easy Street sewer alignment as per Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) procedures. According to our research this project likely fits the categorical exclusion requirements and can be separated from the other EPA funded projects for fulfilling NEPA requirements. However, EPA may still determine this is not the case and require a full environmental assessment document, possibly including the other EPA projects. We have been trying to get definitive EPA input on this situation. In addition, data compiled for the categorical exclusion may lead to the recommendation to prepare as full EA, although we do not believe this will be the case.

Projected work includes

- 1. Preparation of the categorical exclusion report according to criteria and format outlined in EPA guidance.
- The report and associated documents and maps will be provided on electronic media as Adobe Acrobat .pdf files, and ArcGIS shapefiles. Copying and report production for hardcopies is not included for the draft or final reports.
- 3. Cultural resources inventories and National Register evaluations.

The following is not included but will be provided at additional cost as needed.

- 1. Meeting requirements of any agency other than those identified above (i.e. adding other agency requirements might increase the time commitments and costs).
- 2. Additional specialists or consultants not currently employed by QSI.
- 3. Completion of a full environmental assessment document.

We can begin work on the project as soon as we are notified to proceed, and completion of the categorical exclusion documentation to be submitted to EPA is expected to be within 45 to 60 days. However, we will prioritize this work to try to complete it as short a time as possible. Public and/or agency responses will be allowed 30 days (included in total project timeframe).

Our proposed not to exceed costs to complete the categorical exclusion documentation are:

- 1. Archeological/cultural resources Level III inventory to SD SHPO standards - not to exceed \$917.70; plus
- 2. Categorical exclusion research, public and agency scoping, and documentation according to EPA guidance - not to exceed \$4,860.00.

Payment within 10 days of the invoice date receives a 2% discount. Prepayment of an account prior to starting work provides you with a 10% discount (i.e. total not to exceed \$5,199.93). Applicable South Dakota sales tax will be charged unless this work is being conducted for resale or billed directly to a government entity and you provide required documentation.
