RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Vacation of a Major Drainage Easement be approved with the following stipulation:

1. Prior to Public Works Committee approval, the proposed Major Drainage Easement shall be recorded at the Register of Deed's Office and a copy of the recorded document shall be submitted to the Growth Management Department.

GENERAL COMMENTS:

The applicant has submitted a request to vacate a Major Drainage Easement located on Lot 2, NWE Subdivision. In addition, the applicant has submitted documentation identifying an alternate location for the Major Drainage Easement on the property.

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The property was originally platted in 1998. The existing Major Drainage Easement was dedicated on the plat in anticipation of future development on the property. The applicant is proposing to relocate the easement to the actual location of the existing drainage channel that currently runs through the property.

The property is located south of the intersection of Knutson Lane and Sturgis Road on the west side of Sturgis Road. Currently, a single family residence and a shed are located on the property.

STAFF REVIEW:

Staff has reviewed the Vacation of a Major Drainage Easement request and has noted the following considerations:

<u>Drainage</u>: As noted above, the applicant has submitted documentation proposing to dedicate an alternate Major Drainage Easement to accommodate the existing drainage channel that runs through the property. City staff has reviewed and approved the proposed location and size of the alternate Major Drainage Easement. Prior to Public Works Committee approval, the proposed Major Drainage Easement must be recorded at the Register of Deed's Office and a copy of the recorded document must be submitted to the Growth Management Department.

Staff recommends that the Vacation of Major Drainage Easement request be approved with the stipulation of approval as identified above.
