Floodway Tract of Lombardy Industrial Park – Section 8, T1N, R8E

Dear Karley,

Please find attached a Temporary Construction Easement exhibit and an 8.5"x11" RapidMap exhibit showing the location of the proposed construction easement. The temporary construction easement is for drainage outlet improvements from Lot 9 of Block 1 of Lombardy Industrial Park owned by Hook Enterprises Limited Partnership. A building permit application will be submitted within the next few days for a new cold storage building to be located on the aforementioned lot.

Based on our conversation on April 14, 2010, the proposed improvements on Lot 9 will require both stormwater quality and quantity treatment. Due to the lack of adequate drainage facilities in Lombardy Drive and lack of topographic relief, a portion of the proposed drainage improvements will direct stormwater to the Floodway Tract. The proposed improvements include discharging treated stormwater from a portion of Lot 9 onto the Floodway Tract. The area of developed property contributing to the existing spill point in the southeast corner of Lot 9 is approximately 0.5 acres; under existing conditions the contributing area is approximately 0.3 acres. The stormwater will be discharged through an on-site detention facility will continue south across the Floodway Tract to Rapid Creek. The drainage report that will accompany the building permit application will outline actual contributing areas and the proposed improvements.

The temporary construction easement is necessary to install permanent turf reinforcement matting down the existing slope from the crest to the toe. The total length of the matting that will be on City property is approximately 50 feet.

It is our understanding that the temporary construction easement request must be approved by the Legal and Finance Committee. Please forward the attached exhibit through the City Attorney's Office for inclusion in the upcoming Legal and Finance Committee agenda.


