TweetMy311 makes it easy to submit 311 service requests using a smart phone and Twitter. It's [designed to work](#) with the Open311 API being deployed by cities in the United States and Canada.

Currently, the service only works in the San Francisco metropolitan area. As more cities adopt the Open311 standard, it will be possible to enable TweetMy311 in those areas. You can find out more about the Open311 standard and the initiative behind it [here](#).
