Jeri Taton Administrative Assistant (605) 394-5225 Governor Mike Rounds recently announced that the City of Rapid City received a Recreational Trails Program Grant in the amount of \$200,000 to be used for construction of new recreational trails in the Deadwood Drainage area. This trail project will provide a new link for recreational trail users as well as commuters riding to and from the industrial center.

Lon Van Deusen, Parks & Cemetery Manager (605) 394-4175 In order to accept this grant, the City must provide matching funds totaling 20% of the project.

Doug Lowe, Recreation Manager (605) 394-6161 At their meeting on July 8th, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board voted unanimously to reallocate \$40,000 in contingency funds from the Restroom Renovation Project to the Deadwood Drainage Trail Project. The Restroom Renovation project is winding down and will be complete in the near future.
