

SUBSIDY COMMITTEE MINUTES

Finance Officer Pauline Sumption called the meeting to order at 3:00 P.M. with the following Committee members present: Mayor Alan Hanks, Council President Ron Kroeger, Council Vice President Aaron Costello, United Way Executive Director Renee Parker, Assistant Finance Officer Jim Barbier and Community Development Director Barb Garcia. Others included Administrative Coordinator Sharlene Mitchell.

It was noted that the Allied Arts will receive \$100,000, which is one half of the subsidy fund. Each organization's request was discussed by the committee and funding recommendations were made.

Discussion followed regarding identification of a permanent funding source for the Canyon Lake Senior Center and Minneluzahan Senior Center to allow the funds to be utilized by other organizations and insuring that recipients adhere to the program reporting requirements.

Motion was made by Parker, second by Costello and approved to recommend funding of the following subsidy requests as amended and to require that all subsidy recipients continue to provide the mid-year reports:
