A brief summary:

The Rapid City All-Nighter continues to be a very popular Adult Slow-Pitch softball tournament for the area. This tournament consistently produces around 60 teams every year. This constitutes around 800 participants and 400 – 500 Fans. Typically there are around 20-25 teams participate in a normal tournament here in Rapid City at Star of the West Sports Complex.
