



LETTER OF INTENT

December 2, 2010

This Letter of Intent is for Sidewalk Vending Permits. The submittal is for 5 different locations around Downtown Rapid City, specifically locations 1,2,3,5, and 7. The applicant's intent is to abide by all ordinances stated in the Rapid City municipal code 5.56.

As stated in the City of Rapid City ordinance, the vendor is allowed to sell "cut flowers, food and/or non-alcoholic beverages". The applicant is planning this venture in two steps. The initial step will be to sell non-alcoholic beverages and cut flowers. The next step will be to sell food. The vendor company will not begin to sell food until all appropriate and required licenses of the State of South Dakota and Local Health Authorities be submitted to the City of Rapid City. Also at the time of the license submittal, the applicant will supply a list of proposed food for sale.

The "Vending Unit" as noted on the included plans will be the area where all items will be sold. All non-alcoholic beverage storage/sale, food, and flower sales will not exceed the maximum 60 sq.ft.
