I am writing this letter to request that the Boy Scouts of America, Black Hills Area Council conduct a "Day Camp" here in Rapid City on the 24th and 25th of June 2011. This event will include, with your authorization, a BB-Gun Range, Archery Range and a Sling Shot Range. This is a vital part of educating our youth on the safe and responsible handling of fire-arms and other weapons common to the South Dakota landscape.

We are committed to the safety of the youth participating and will have Boy Scouts of America Guide to Safe Scouting standards in place which include: Range instructors overseen by, at a minimum, an NRA Certified Range instructor, BSA Standard Range setups which include backstops, eye protection, firing BB Guns only from the prone position (laying down) and a safety briefing for every youth who handles any equipment, numerous other standards are also in place for safety precautions. For many of the youth attending this will be the first time they have ever been exposed to the shooting sports and we hope to make it a safe, educational, and fun experience for all attending.

In the event that this activity is approved we can provide a certificate of insurance for both the event and the members who are attending. These are shooting sports programs that are run across the country in a safe manner and we look forward to providing our youth here in Rapid City with the same opportunities.


