To Whom it may concern,

I, Lisa White, have resided at 829 Saint Cloud Street since February of 2005. I would like to request an allowance of a 6' Privacy fence to replace my lower fencing around the fenced portions of my residence. The lower height of the fencing allows the heavy pedestrian traffic the opportunity to pull the pickets off from the fencing framework, throw any items they would like to discard easily into the back portion of my yard as well as deny my right to privacy on a daily basis. During my residency at 829 Saint Cloud Street I have continuously replaced wooden pickets from my existing fence facing 9<sup>th</sup> Street which measures 60' 8". I would also like to request to raise the 10' 8" portion of fencing as well as the portions of 110' 6" and 7' 6" to 6' privacy fencing that are not all ready 6'. The varied fencing heights in the alley portion of my residence do not provide adequate security for my family as well as the community. Currently there is a small recession next to the garage. It was there to house the old metal trash cans to be picked up by the sanitation department easily. With upgrades to the system it made the wooden holding area obsolete. I have in the past seen this small area become a resting place for homeless individuals. Eliminating the nook and raising the fence in this area should eliminate the nook for homeless and, secure my trash receptacle until trash pick-up days. I believe the change to the back portion of the fencing will improve the alleys appearance as well as create a safer environment for the children who use the alley to access the Big D store. Raising the front portions to the 6' level and aligning them with the front of the home would also improve the security as well as allow a more decorative appearance. Thank you for taking the time to review my request.
