Dear Sir,

Please let this serve as Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Black Hills' Letter of Intent to conduct a raffle called "The BIG Golf Ball Drop". The event is scheduled for August 18, 2011, 7pm, at Dakota Middle School Football Field, Rapid City, SD. Up to 5000 numbered golf balls will be dropped from a fire truck onto a target area set up in the arena. Twenty pin/flags will be set up in the target area denoting chances to win prizes. The golf ball which lands closest to the Grand Prize Pin and 18 Pins will win a cash prize. The ball closest to the pin/flag will be determined by three judges who will measure in a straight line from the pin/flag to the ball. The Hole In-One Pin cash prize will be awarded only if a ball lands in the hole. Winners need not be present to win.

Prizes include:

- Grand Prize Pin/Flag: \$3000.00 cash
- Pin/Flags 1-18: Cash Prize \$100/each (Total of \$1800.00)
- Hole-In-One Pin: Cash Prize \$1500

Numbered raffle tickets, representing a numbered golf ball, will be sold for \$5 each state wide as well as nationally through our website.
