


Rapid City Public Libraries

2010 IN REVIEW

Nearly 1.2 Million Circulations in 2010!

For the second year, circulations hit a record level and exceeded the 1 million mark; a total of 1, 176, 015 circulations showed a **15**% increase over 2009.

There was a **70**% increase in digital material circulations as this format continues to gain in popularity.



Compared to 2009, there were increases in number of computers and patron contacts which were +15% and +16% respectively.



Factors Contributing to these Increases

1. Compared nationally to libraries serving similar patron bases, the Rapid City Public Library has...

30% higher than average circulation

11% higher than average library visits

11 points higher than average % of population with library cards

2. Research states local information is hardest to find. Rapid City Public Library provides comprehensive local resources through the online Knowledge Network.










