



- 1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SECURE ALL REQUIRED PERMITS PRIOR TO BEGINNING WORK
- ALL EXISTING UTILITIES MAY NOT BE SHOWN OR THE LOCATIONS MAY VARY FROM THAT SHOWN. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE TO HAVE ALL UTILITIES LOCATED PRIOR TO ECONOMIC MAPS MY
- 2. ALL SITE LAYOUT DATA IS BASED ON A SURVEY PROVIDED BY CETEC ENGINEERING, BUILDING FACADES PROVIDED BY CHARRENLAN ARCHITECTS, AND ALLEY IMPROVEMENTS PROVIDED BY ARONT DESIGN. REPORT AND DISCREPANCIES TO THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT FLAFFIXATELY.
- 4. ALL WORK SHALL COMPLY WITH THE CITY OF RAPID CITY STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION (THE 20)7 EDITION)
- 6. ALL CONCRETE WORK SHALL COMPLY WITH ALBERTSON ENGINEERING STRUCTURAL NOTES
- 6. LOCATION OF EXISTING UTLITIES SHOWN ON THESE DRAWINGS ARE APPROXIMATE AND WERE TAKEN FROM THE BEST AVAILABLE RECORDS. PRIOR TO EXCAVATION THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PIECU VERIFIE "EXACT LOCATION OF ALL UTLITIES WHETHER OR NOT SHOWN ON THESE DRAWINGS. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROTECT ALL UTLITIES DURING CONSTRUCTION. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROTE ON THANKL UNDER EXISTING UTILITIES IN A MANINER THAT THE EXISTING UTILITIES ARE NOT DAMAGED OR OSISTURBED. UNLIESS OTHERWISE NOTED, ANY DISTURBANCE OR REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING UTILITIES SHALL BE HIGGENTAL TO THE PROJECT. IF REQUIRED, CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE RELOCATION OF UTILITY WITH THE UTILITY OWNER. ALL UTILITIES ARE TO BE ADJUSTED ANDOR RELOCATED BY THE RESPECTIVE UTILITY COMPANIES UNLESS OTHERWISE INDICATED IN THESE PROMYMISE.
- 7 TEMPORARY EROSION CONTROL SHALL BE THE CONTRACTORS RESPONSIBILITY AND SHALL CONSIST OF STRAW BALES, SILT FENCE OR OTHER MEANS TO CONTROL EROSION AS NEEDED EROSION CONTROL SHALL BE BY ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY STANDARDS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION.
- 8. MAINTENANCE SHALL BE PERFORMED ON ALL EROSION CONTROL PRACTICES AS SPECIFIED IN THE APPROVIED STORM WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION PLAN, PREPARED AND SUBMITTED BY THE CONTRACTOR.
- 9 ALL MATERIAL TESTING SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR, THE FREQUENCY OF MATERIAL TESTING SHALL BE AN ACCORDANCE WITH INDUSTRY STANDARDS.

- 7 TEMPORARY EROSION CONTROL SHALL BE THE CONTRACTORS RESPONSIBILITY AND SHALL CONSIST OF STRAW BALES, SILT FENCE OR OTHER HIEARS TO CONTROL EROSION AS NEEDED, EROSION CONTROL SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY STANDARDS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION
- MAINTEWANCE SHALL BE PERFORMED ON ALL EROSION CONTROL PRACTICES AS SPECIFIED IN THE APPROVED STORM WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION PLAY, PREPARED AND SUBMITTED BY THE CONTRACTOR.
- ALL MATERIAL TESTING SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR, THE FREQUENCY OF MATERIAL TESTING SHALL BE AIN ACCORDANCE WITH INDUSTRY STANDARDS.
- 10. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL WITH THE CITY OF RAPID CITY'S STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION REGIANDING DUST CONTRACL DUST CONTRACT, PERMITS SHALL BE CRITAINED PRIOR TO DEGINNING WORK. - 12. CONSTRUCTION LIMITS. IN GENERAL, THE CONSTRUCTION LIMITS FOR THE PROJECT SHALL BE DEFINED AS POLLOWS.
- 12.1 PROPERTY LINES, RIGHT OF-WAY (ROW) UNES, AND EXISTING UTILITY EASEMENT LINES SHALL BE THE CONSTRUCTION LIMITS UNLESS INDICATED OTHERWISE ON THE DRAWNIGS.
- 12.2 CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES SHALL BE RESTRICTED TO THE CONSTRUCTION LIMITS UNLESS PRIOR APPROVAL IS RECEIVED FROM THE ENGINEER. USE OF CITY LANDS FOR STACING AVEAS, MATERIAL, STORAGE, SEDMENTATION PONDS DEWATERING ANDIOR TOPSCIL, STOCOPILING SHALL, ONLY BE WITH PROOF WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE CITY, ANY DAMAGES AND RESTORATION OUTSIDE THE CONSTRUCTION LIMITS SHALL BE AT THE CONTRACTORS DEPENSE.
