I am aware that the Friendship House property on Silver Street has been abandoned by Sheriff Thom and that the half-way house occupants have moved into the Adams Street Facility.

I am also aware that it is Sheriff Thom's opinion that the building is unfit for future use.

If this is true, and I believe it is, I would like to offer the building as a training aid for the Rapid City/Pennington County Special Response Team (SRT). I know they would like to use the building to practice forced-entries to rooms using various breaching equipment, including explosive breaching equipment. The training would be closely supervised to ensure a safe environment.

Since the training would be destructive, we would coordinate with the planned demolition of the building.
