Dear Mr. Patterson:

I have received and reviewed your application for a security license. A background check documented your criminal history and revealed an arrest and a violation that you failed to disclose on your application. I have concluded after a review of this information that your record makes you unsuitable for licensing for security work and your application is denied.

You should be aware that I do not have the last say in this instance. If you feel aggrieved by my decision, you may contact Ms. Pauline Sumption, the Rapid City Finance Officer and ask that your situation be placed on the Council agenda for a hearing before the Rapid City Common Council. You must make this request within ten days of receipt of this letter and a hearing will be scheduled.

At that hearing, I will present your entire history to the Council and you will have an opportunity to explain that record.

I also believe it is my duty to inform you that you do not have the right to provide security and that every day in which you provide this security is a separate count if you are charged. If you should have any questions please contact me.

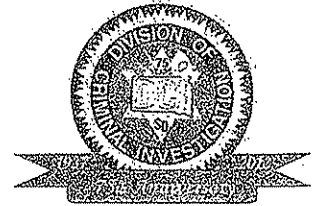
