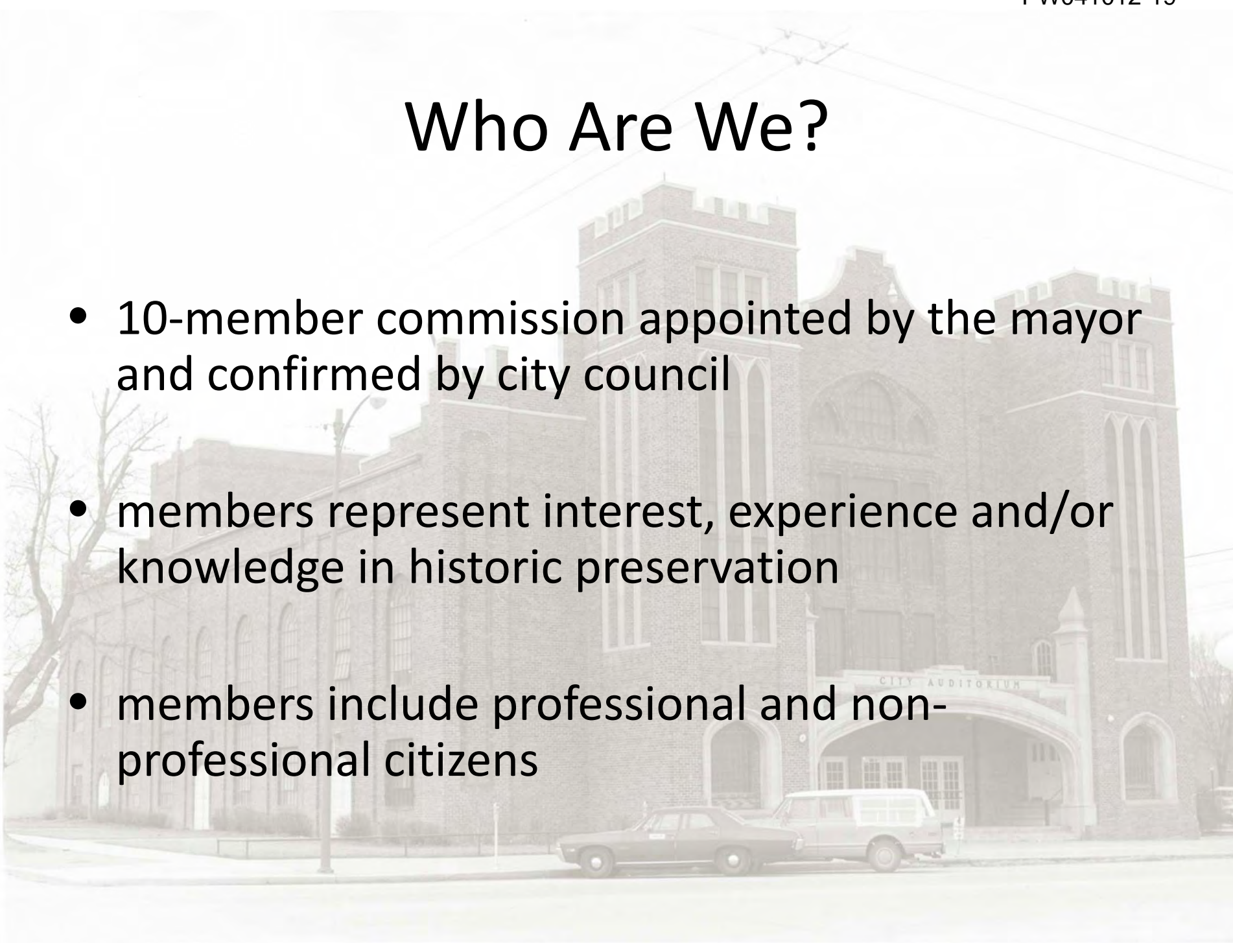

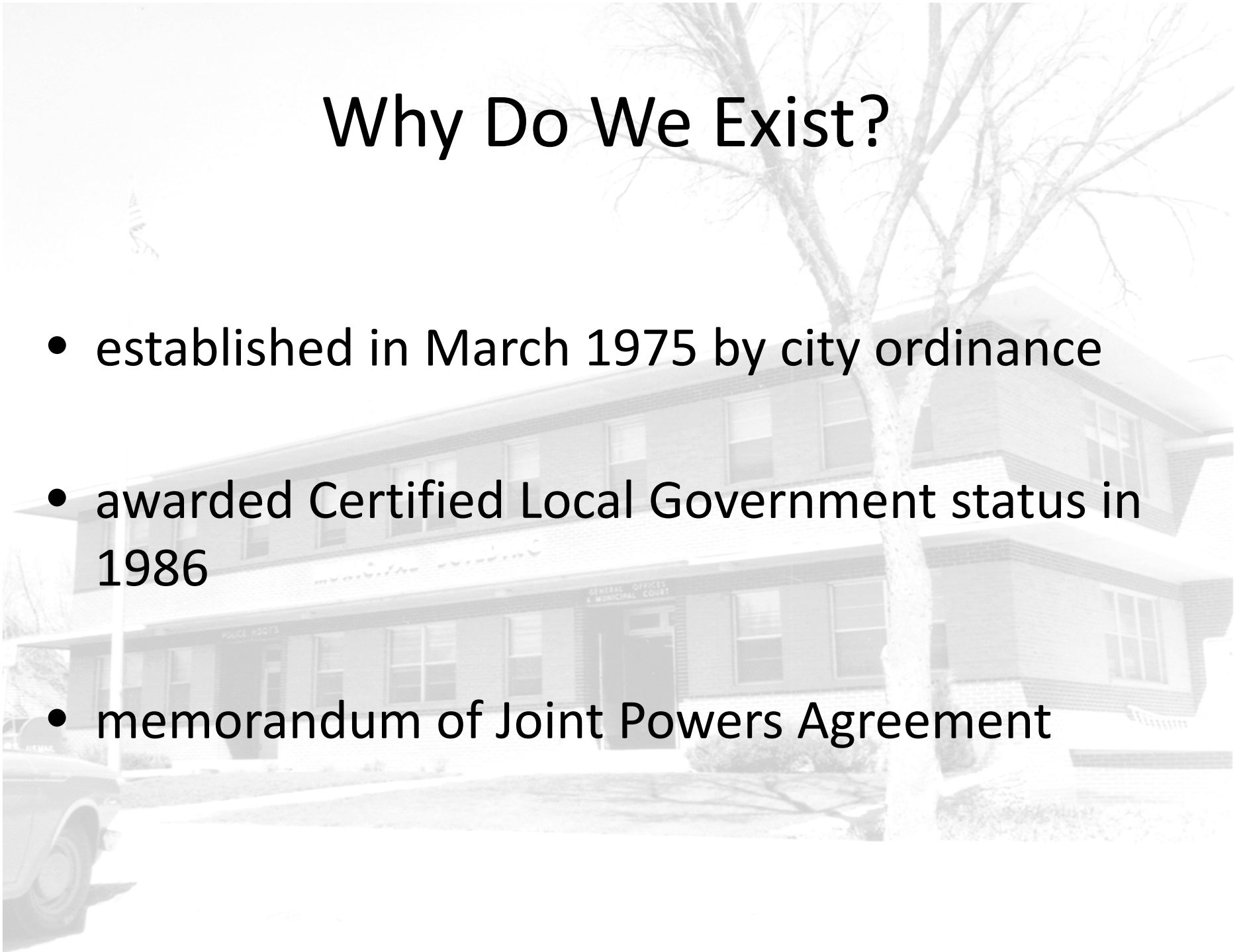
Who Are We?

- 10-member commission appointed by the mayor and confirmed by city council
- members represent interest, experience and/or knowledge in historic preservation
- members include professional and non-professional citizens



Why Do We Exist?

- established in March 1975 by city ordinance
- awarded Certified Local Government status in 1986
- memorandum of Joint Powers Agreement

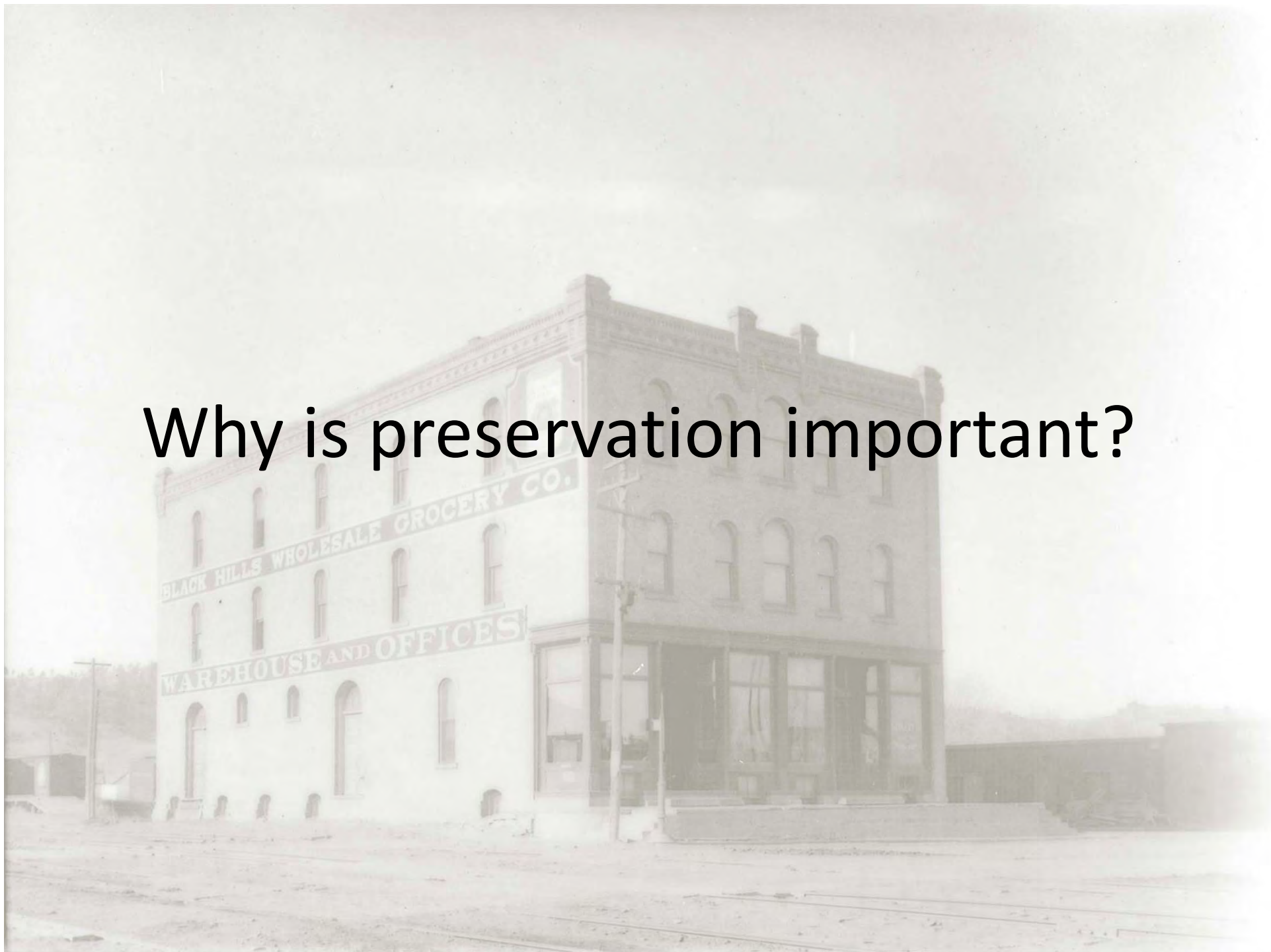


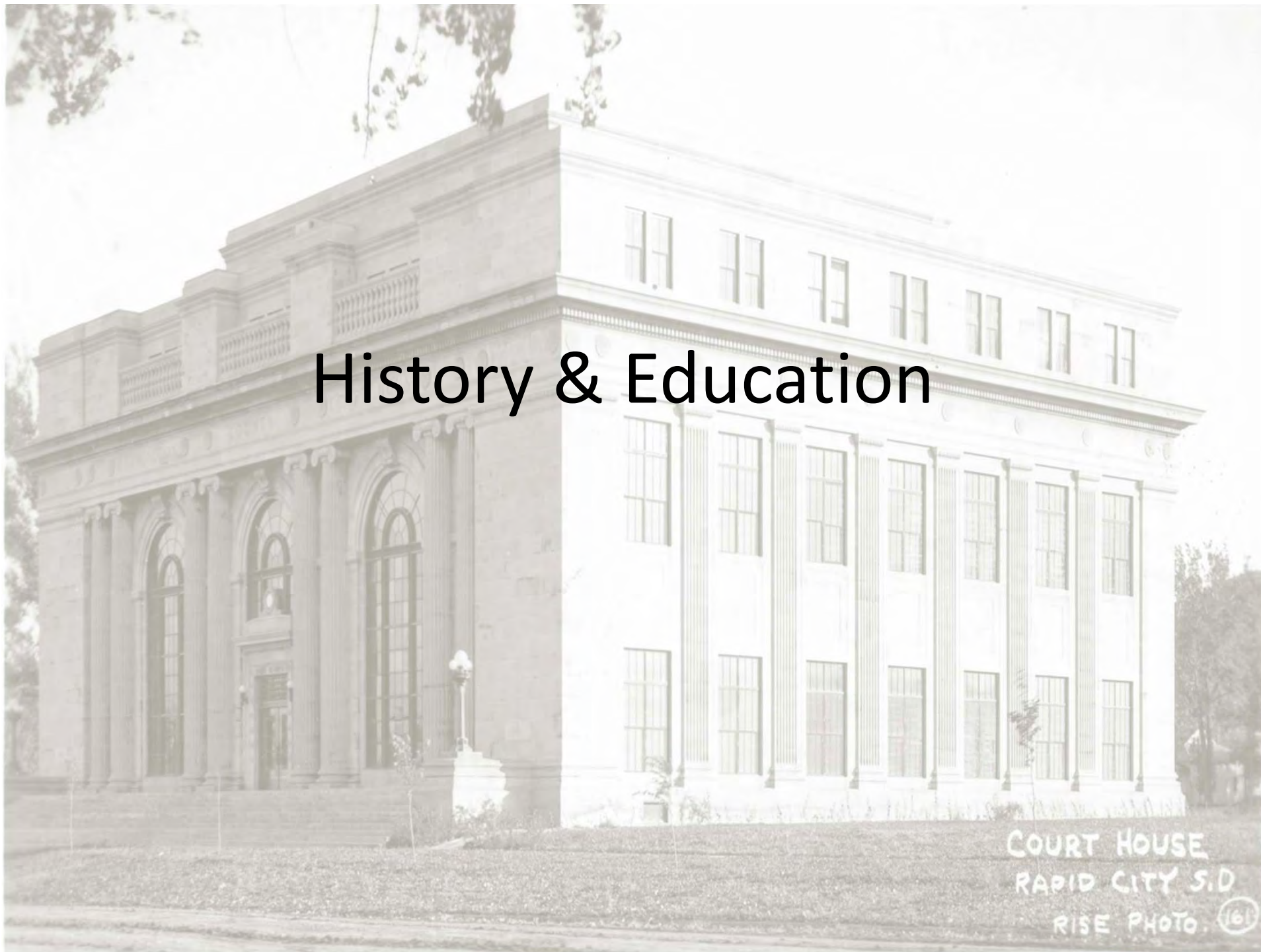
What are our responsibilities?

- CLG's must perform responsibilities delegated to them under NHPA & must enforce state & local laws for the designation and protection of historic properties.
- identification, documentation & protection of resources
- conduct 11.1 reviews
- coordinate with local planning processes
- provide education and outreach
- provide support to property owners
- recommend ordinances
