Zion Lutheran School would be interested in a partnership with Beth-Anne Ferley, Recycling Educator for the City of Rapid City Solid Waste Division as she applies for an Environmental Education grant from the EPA. It is our understanding that this grant would be used for the indoor furnishings of the Education Center at the landfill.

It is also our understanding that through this grant Rapid City Solid Waste Division will be constructing a Recycling Education Center as part of a Citizen Campus. The Education Center will be filled with hands-on learning tools, education lessons, garden supplies and tools, and service learning activities that will be used to increase knowledge and awareness of the three R's: reduce-reuse-recycle and environmental sustainability. South Dakota Education Standards will be addressed for third grade science, technology, environment and society. Standard 3.S.1.1 especially focuses on students recognizing ways to reduce reuse recycle and reduce consumption of natural resources. These standards will be the main emphasis of the Education Center. This grant will focus on third grade students, of which Zion will participate. Future focus will include preschool through fifth grade students. All of our teachers have expressed and interest in this project and plan to participate as the project is completed. The Education Center would be used to support our teachers in their lessons and to change students recycling behaviors.

Currently Zion is in the beginning phases of a recycling program for our church and school. Zion's current enrollment is 166 students. However we will also include members of our church's youth group in our recycling program.

We look forward to working with Beth-Anne Ferley as this project progresses.
