CONTRACT FOR SCULPTURE

This contract made and entered into by and between JAMES VAN NUYS GALLERY LLC, 516 SIXTH ST. RAPID CITY, SOUTH DAKOTA 57701, hereinafter referred to as VAN NUYS, and BLACK HILLS VETERANS MEMORIAL PROJECT, hereinafter referred to as VETERANS MEMORIAL PROJECT.

WITNESSETH: That VAN NUYS hereby agrees to create a work of art for the VETERANS MEMORIAL PROJECT, upon the following terms and conditions.

I.

That **VAN NUYS** shall create a life-size sculpture of an eagle, hereinafter referred to as **SCULPTURE**, in cast bronze in a similar manner as other sculptures previously created by **VAN NUYS**.

II.

That the **SCULPTURE** created by **VAN NUYS** will be similar to the drawings, as approved by the **VETERANS MEMORIAL PROJECT.**

III.

VAN NUYS warranties the **SCULPTURE** against defects in material or workmanship for a period of twenty (20) years.

IV.

That the consideration for preparing the **SCULPTURE** shall be a guaranteed sum of \$30,000 (thirty thousand dollars). This amount does not include applicable taxes. That the consideration shall be paid in six (6) payments over the period TBD:

- **A.** \$5,000 (\$5,300 if taxable) due on the date of signing of this contract by both parties. [Projected: TBD, 2014.]
- **B.** \$5,000 (\$5,300 if taxable) progress payment date to be determined (TBD).
- C. \$5,000 (\$5,300 if taxable) progress payment TBD.

- D. \$5,000 (\$5,300 if taxable) progress payment TBD.
- E. \$5,000 (\$5,300 if taxable) progress payment TBD.
- F. \$5,000 (\$5,300 if taxable) progress payment TBD.

V.

The **VETERANS MEMORIAL PROJECT** is responsible for any/all applicable state or local sales, use or excise taxes. VAN NUYS is responsible for reporting and submitting all state or local sales, use, or excise taxes to the South Dakota Department of Revenue.

VI.

It is understood that **VAN NUYS** will transport and deliver the **SCULPTURE** to the site at Memorial Park in Rapid City, South Dakota, and supervise the installation of the **SCULPTURE**.

VII.

This contract may be terminated upon the occurrence of any of the following:

- **A. VAN NUYS** shall have the right to terminate this contract in the event the **VETERANS MEMORIAL PROJECT** is more than ninety (90) days past due in making any payment required by this contract.
- B. This contract shall not automatically terminate on the death of VAN NUYS. JAMES VAN NUYS GALLERY will complete the SCULPTURE according to VAN NUYS' original designs and plans. VAN NUYS' estate shall thereupon have the right to retain any payment made for work that was completed and accepted by the VETERANS MEMORIAL PROJECT.
- C. If this contract is terminated by the death of VAN NUYS prior to all necessary designs being completed, VAN NUYS' estate shall repay the VETERANS MEMORIAL FUND all money paid to VAN NUYS under this contract.
- D. Any notice of termination shall be given First Class Certified Mail, return receipt requested by **VAN NUYS** and/or the **VETERANS MEMORIAL PROJECT** at the above listed addresses.

I am attaching front and side view sketches of my proposed sculpture for the Black Hills Veterans Memorial. I will be sending a sample bid/contract form later this morning, which can be modified as necessary. If we sign the contract, my next step would probably be to make a full-size cardboard mock-up and photograph it on the monument so that the client can see how big it would actually look. At this point, the scale in the drawings is just a guess. The length of an eagle's wing (one wing, not both) at life-size is about 3 feet. So with the feet and body, I'm guessing the eagle would be about four feet high. The ball on which he stands would add another foot. That could be a more natural looking rock base if preferred. the ball seems to be somewhat standard in military emblems/sculptures.
