SPECIFICATIONS FOR ICE SANDING MATERIAL Rapid City, South Dakota

Bids will be received at the Rapid City Finance Office, 300 Sixth Street, Rapid City, South Dakota on September 25, 2012 until 2:00 P.M. for furnishing ICE SANDING MATERIAL which shall meet the following specifications:

SCOPE

It is the intent of these specifications to describe ICE SANDING MATERIAL in sufficient detail to secure bids on comparable ICE SANDING MATERIAL. All parts not specifically mentioned, which are necessary in order to provide ICE SANDING MATERIAL shall be included in the bid and shall conform in strength, quality of material and workmanship to what is usually provided the trade in general.

The City's intent is to obtain a reasonable bid from all qualified bidders. If for any reason bidders are unable to meet or equal the following specifications, the City will receive for consideration minor deviations of specifications. Deviations and variations of specifications must be fully detailed and explained by the bidder on the form provided and stapled to the BIDDER'S PROPOSAL.

All bids must be accompanied by literature completely describing the ICE SANDING MATERIAL to be furnished. Each bidder must be a certified dealer authorized by the manufacturer he represents. Each bid shall contain a dealer and/or factory warranty as a guarantee of the product to be furnished. The guarantee shall be stated in the descriptive literature or by a letter.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1) Bidders Information

Each bid envelope shall contain <u>ONLY ONE</u> (1) Bid Proposal and shall be marked with the words "Sealed Bid – ICE SANDING MATERIAL".

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check or cashier's check in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid, such check to be certified or issued by either a State or National Bank and payable to the City of Rapid City, South Dakota, or in lieu there of, a bid bond for ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid, such bond to be issued by a surety authorized to do business in this State, payable to the City of Rapid City, Rapid City, South Dakota, as a guarantee of the bidder entering into a contract, for the supplying of ICE SANDING MATERIAL for the City of Rapid City. After the terms of the contract have been met, the bidder's check or bid bond will be returned to the successful bidder. Checks or bonds of all the unsuccessful bidders will be returned within thirty (30) days after the bids have been opened.

Bids submitted by mail, express courier, or common carrier cannot be accepted unless received in the City Finance Office prior to the time for the scheduled bid opening. Bids submitted by telefax cannot be accepted.

Each bid envelope shall contain the entire set of specifications and a completed "ARTICLE 5 CONTRACT DOCUMENT" upon submittal of the bid. Incomplete bids will be rejected.

To the extent provided by statute, preference will be given to materials, products, and supplies found or produced within the State of South Dakota. (SDCL Chapter 5-18A.)

The City reserves the right to reject all bids and unless all bids presented are rejected, the lowest responsible bid, in all cases, will be accepted. In case the low bid is not responsible or the bid is not made in accordance with the requirements of SDCL Chapters 5-18A through 5-18D or the low bid is withdrawn, the bid of the next lowest responsible bidder may be accepted; however, to the extent allowed by law the City reserves the right to accept the bid that is to the advantage of and is in the best interest of the City of Rapid City.

Payment for the ICE SANDING MATERIAL will be made BY CHECK, within a reasonable time after and approval by the Common Council.

The unit price of the bid must be stated on the Bidder's Proposal form, along with the extended price bid. Unit price shall take precedence over extended price; written figures shall take precedence over numerical figures.

The ICE SANDING MATERIAL shall be delivered F.O.B., Street Division, 605 Steele Avenue, Rapid City, South Dakota.

The quantities shown in the proposal are approximate for 2013. It shall be understood that the City of Rapid City reserves the right to purchase more or less than the specified amounts as it deems expedient. Purchases made by the City of Rapid City are subject to available funding. If the Rapid City Council fails to approve additional funding for this purchase in the 2013 budget, the City of Rapid City will not be obligated to purchase any additional ICE SANDING MATERIAL.

Bids and quotations shall be for the period starting October 2, 2012, and ending approximately one year later and shall show net delivered prices without State or Federal taxes. The City of Rapid City requires firm bids from all bidders. The City reserves the right to reject any bid not stating a firm price as not responsive.

All prices shall be F.O.B., Rapid City South Dakota to Street Division.

2) Rejection

If the material does not meet the requirements of these specifications, notice shall be given to the vendor within thirty (30) days after the receipt of the ICE SANDING MATERIAL. In this event, payment shall be withheld, and the vendor shall remove the product from the City premises and shall replace it with a like amount of acceptable ICE SANDING MATERIAL.

3) Contract Extension

The City of Rapid City annually reserves the option of extending the 2013 contract through the calendar years of 2014, 2015 and 2016. The extension option may be exercised if agreed to by both parties.

DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS

The sand to be used for ice conditions on the street shall conform to the following specifications:

#200	0-2%

- 1) Materials supplied shall be clean, durable and free of any deleterious substances.
- 2) Scale tickets showing weight and type of material will be submitted with each load.
- 3) Sand shall be all naturally deposited or partially impacted to meet specifications. No crushed limestone or crushed rock, other than a natural sand, will be permitted.
- 4) The liquid limit of the material shall not exceed 26 and the Plastic Index shall not exceed 3. The material shall not contain more than 25% calcite, as determined by x-ray defraction analysis.
- 5) The City will try to give the supplier as much advanced notification as possible on delivery but conditions may warrant that delivery on the sand request should begin within 24 hours.
- 6) Quality tests to determine the percentage of calcite contained in the material are required. Sand shall be sampled such that portions of the sample are taken from 3 to 5 different locations throughout the stockpile and thoroughly mixed. The sample shall be delivered to the Mineral Industries testing laboratory on the South Dakota School of Mines and Technology campus. The telephone number is 394-2496. Payment for this test shall be the responsibility of the bidder. Satisfactory test result shall be obtained and submitted with the bid.
- 7) A durability or hardness as defined in Mohs scale of greater than 6 for 70 percent of the material applied to the streets for deicing or skid control;
- 8) No more than 3 percent of the total particle material content by weight may pass through a No. 200 sieve as described in ASTM C136-93, "Standard Test Method for Sieve Analysis of Fine and Course Aggregates," November, 1993.
