Executive Summary

- BAIR Analytics provides both remote and embedded BAIR Crime Analysts to perform crime analysis functions.
- The analyst can either be remote, working part or full time or can work full-time at the customer's location.
- The analyst will be trained in all aspects of crime analysis (operational, tactical, strategic, and administrative crime analysis).
- BAIR will provide reach-back support for embedded analysts in their absence (sick, vacation, training etc.) thus providing the agency with 52-week coverage.
- The cost for an embedded BAIR Analyst is \$70,000 with one-year contract.
- The cost for a remote BAIR Analyst is \$85 per hour with a one-year contract.
- Resumes will be provided to the customer in aiding in the selection of the embedded BAIR Analyst for approval.

The following sections outline our proposal to provide regular analytical services to the customer, improving its efficiency and effectiveness while substantially reducing costs.




Capabilities:

Products

All of our reports contain input from the various analytical expertise within our shop. In today's analytical world, it has become too costly and unrealistic to hope that any one analyst can have the acumen of link analysis, spatial analysis, temporal analysis, statistical analysis, behavioral analysis, coupled with and in the context of all the discipline specific knowledge of the criminal justice system. In addition, in order to perform high-quality analysis, an analyst not only needs to have knowledge of these areas but also how to leverage data sources, be accustomed to extensive data formats and even possess basic knowledge of database design and use. It is too much to ask of any one analyst and thus, the agency is forced to either make everyone a generalist or hire more analysts which possess any one of these skills. Once the regional



agencies designate the needed analytical reports and schedule, BAIR Analysts will efficiently complete their analysis and deliver findings on time.

Data:

BAIR understands data and has extensive access to it even beyond what the customer could access. With RAIDS and ATACRAIDS, both national incident sharing systems developed and housed by us, we have access to a vast array of relevant data. In our RAIDS/ATACRAIDS systems we have the following current data:

- Nearly 20 million incident records.
- 330+ agencies and adding more each day.

We have the ability to use the meaningful data and our expertise to search for specifics such as:

- Gun Crime: Ability to search through narratives for all guns or specific guns.
- Gang Crime: Ability to search through narratives for specific gangs, signs, tattoos, etc.
- We can search all of our data all at once because it is housed in one location.
- We have "reach-back" capability to HQ to identify other national security issues before they arise.

In addition, we have systems that allow us to access arrest and warrant history, residence history, phone numbers, addresses, criminal and civil records, relatives and associates, driving records, bankruptcies, corporate records and more.

Strategic Benefit of Analytical Services

The International Association of Crime Analysts conducted a survey in 2008, using 778 Crime Analysts. The survey produced some very interesting results that illuminated the restrictions Crime Analysts face. Below are some highlighted outcomes from the survey, and how BAIR Analytics offsets these disadvantages:

- Only 29% of Analysts hold a Master's degree, and only 29% hold a Bachelor's degree. More
 than half of BAIR employees hold advanced degrees in mathematics, statistics, sociology,
 psychology, criminology and business.
- Nearly 80% of Analysts have been in the Crime Analysis field for less than 10 years. BAIR
 Analysts have decades of combined years of experience in Public Safety, Intelligence, and
 Data Analysis and over 25% are military veterans.
- 85% of Analysts only speak English. The BAIR Team has a combined fluency in Arabic, Russian, French, Spanish, Portuguese and Italian.
- Majority of agencies only have one analyst. BAIR Analytics utilizes a team approach when performing analysis. We draw upon collective experiences and educational backgrounds of our current analysts who are versed in sociology, psychology, business and economics, statistics, mathematics, and justice studies. BAIR has subject matter expertise analysts including: Pattern Analysts, Intelligence Analysts, Military Analyst, Research Analysts, and Civilian Analysts. - 81% of Crime Analysis Units do not have their own IT development staff. BAIR has a team of IT and support specialists that are readily available if any technical issues arise.
- Most Analysts are limited to Microsoft Office, their RMS, and a GIS provider as their main software for analysis. BAIR has access to the most advanced hardware and software including but not limited to ATAC Workstation, ATACRAIDS, ArcGIS, ArcGIS Spatial Analyst, i2 Analyst Notebook, Tracers.com, MS Office, PhotoShop, Illustrator, and a HP Design Jet 500 Plotter.
- Most Analysts perform strategic analysis and threat assessments, mapping/GIS, and prepare charts and reports only as needed or as requested. BAIR can perform many different types of reports (listed below under products) and at any frequency desired by the The customer.



- The majority of Crime Analysts said 80% of their time is spent in a reactive role rather than a proactive role. BAIR Analytics has the capability to automate routine reports, use automated identification techniques, and scan for trends and patterns. With meaningful data, scheduled reports, and continuous pattern identification, The customer would be able to take a proactive role and deploy resources where they are most needed.
- The most significant obstacles that Crime Analysts face are: (1) budget constraints (2) a
 heavy work load (3) lack of technology and tech support and (4) lack of training. (1) BAIR
 Analytics is not burdened by budget constraints and is cost effective for The customer (2) with
 reach back capabilities, BAIR is able to leverage all of our resources (3) BAIR Analytics is
 always equipped with the most advanced hardware and software and (4) all BAIR Analysts are
 fully trained.
- 61% of Analysts believe their unit is understaffed and over worked. The customer will never face this problem with a BAIR Analyst because they will get 40 hours of analysis 52 weeks a year and will always receive the requested reports at the frequency chosen.
- Most Analysts wish there was some form or regional data sharing. With ATACRAIDS, BAIR is
 able to see millions of crime incidents throughout the entire country. There are currently
 more than 330 agencies on the map with more being added every day. We are able to scan
 for trends in the surrounding bay area in efforts to stop any serial offender from committing
 the same act within the county's jurisdiction.
