Fenske Media Corporation earns Sustainability Award

Fenske Media Corporation has made changes that positively affect the community by their use of sustainable practices.

For their efforts, the Rapid City Sustainability Committee will present a Sustainability Award to the Fenske Media Corporation on October 6, 2014. The award will be presented to John Fenske and members of his team.

Fenske Media Corporation is committed to sustainability practices that benefit their business, the environment and give back to the community. Many of these projects have had environmental, economic, and social impacts on our community. Three major changes that Fenske Media has implemented include: Humidification, Lighting updates and Solar Energy.

Humidification has changed from a boiler model to dry fog – the splitting of hydrogen and oxygen molecules. This model uses significantly less energy.

Fenske has updated their entire facilities lighting from 400 Watt metal halite to LED. This new system allows for the capability of dimming the lights to 130 watts during slow or down times which ultimately saves energy.

Finally, Fenske Media has installed new Solar Energy. This new solar farm produces enough energy to give unused energy back to the grid. In the first 60 days after installation the Solar farm generated 25,920 solar Kilowatt Hours and 39,430 Pounds of CO2 offset. This is enough energy to power 29 homes for a month. On Saturday July 12 a "Super moon" cast enough light to create power that was then given back to the grid.
