What we envision is from 1:00 – 4:00 each day we would take the ice cream cart along Main Street and St Joseph Street then over to Legacy Commons Part to sell our ice cream to businesses, employees and families.

We see this as a benefit not only to our business, but also to the feel and vibrancy of our downtown. Our 'traveling' cart would add another big city feel to our growing downtown. We wouldn't be competing with any other ice cream shop in the core. Currently, here are only ordinances for ice cream trucks and to renting a specific corner. We would like to propose that we have a traveling ordinance much like the sandwich cart that went around in the core of downtown in the 1980's.
