Attn. Nicole and the City or Rapid City Engineering Department,
Due to multiple reasons including no existing sidewalks, within entire housing development, fully developed neighborhood, as well as very challenging typography, a sidewalk does not make any sense in this area.

Type of Permit: New garage for a Single Family House.
House is adjacent to Lookout Mountain Road.
Mountain Meadow is the intersecting road with Lookout Mountain Road.

I am requesting a variance to the city code requiring the addition of a sidewalk, while adding a garage to an existing home.

I live in Spring Brook Acres located along Sheridan Lake Road (near Corral Drive).

The closest existing sidewalk to my knowledge is along Sheridan Lake Road (approximately 1+ miles away and roughly 400 feet lower in elevation).

This housing development was originally developed in the 1970's and was part of Pennington County.

As a private housing development we maintain our own streets as part of a H.O.A.

The roads in this area tend to be narrow with significant drop offs, trees and rocky cliffs in most areas.

Development is fully developed as far as I know, so I don't expect any new houses to be built in the area.

I would totally understand doing a sidewalk if this was a new development with numerous houses yet to be built.

But since this would be a sidewalk to nowhere, I see no benefit in adding a sidewalk in this area.
