<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: Staff recommends that the rezoning from No Use Zoning District to Office Commercial Zoning District be continued to the **November 7, 2002** Planning Commission meeting.

<u>GENERAL COMMENTS</u>: This item was continued at the September 26, 2002 and October 10, 2002 Planning Commission meetings. Staff recommends that this request be continued at the applicant's request. New or revised text is shown in bold print. This property is located east of Elk Vale Road and north of Degeest Street. The property was annexed into the City of Rapid City effective May 15, 2002, and is currently in a No Use Zoning District. The No Use Zoning District is a temporary zoning designation utilized when property is annexed into the City of Rapid City, pursuant to the provisions of Section 17.26.020 of the Rapid City Municipal Code. The purpose of this application is to complete that process.

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<u>STAFF REVIEW</u>: Staff has reviewed this proposed rezoning with the property owner. The owner wishes to meet with the Future Land Use Committee regarding the rezoning of this property. Therefore, Staff is recommending this application be continued until the **November 7, 2002** Planning Commission meeting.

Staff has mailed certified letters to notify surrounding property owners of the proposed rezoning and has posted the required sign on this property. As of this date, staff has received no comments or objections regarding this request.
