Draft legislation language –1-19B-3. Composition of preservation commission--Residence--Terms of office. The Historic Preservation Commission shall consist of not less than five nor more than ten members, who shall be appointed by the governing body with due regard to proper representation of such fields as history, architecture, urban planning,

archaeology, paleontology, and law. All members of the commission ~~shall reside within the jurisdiction of the county or municipality establishing the commission and~~ shall serve for terms not to exceed three years, being eligible for reappointment as shall be specified by the governing body.
Residency requirements shall be as specified by the governing body.

Our Historic Preservation Commission met last week to discuss the legislative amendment that would eliminate the residency requirements for HPC members.

A lot of the members shared the same concern as those mentioned by Kevin Kuchenbecker in Deadwood.

Although they understand the difficulty of having enough interested members in the community to serve on the HPC, they do not feel comfortable with the possibility of outside figures being the decision makers for the historic districts in the community.

The Commission would be curious to hear of other solutions that would narrow down the people that could be selected, or possible ways to get more community members excited to be on the commission and serve it properly.
