The windows are Jeld-Wen double hung windows with low-e coating. They are 30"x60" the same size as the existing windows.

The siding is AP building products USA, smooth face composite lap siding . I believe it's made of repurposed materials and is 12" wide cut to 5" wide. After installation it has a 3.5" reveal which is the same as the existing siding, to be painted the same color as the rest of the house.
