

Minutes Historic Sign Review Committee July 24, 2009

Mattison called the meeting to order at 8:34 am.

711 Main Street, Oasis Lounge, Inc – Awning Sign

Geiger moved and Mattison seconded to approve the awning sign for the Oasis Lounge at 711 Main Street. In response to a question by Mattison, French explained the colors of the awning sign and the logo and lettering to be placed on the sign. The motion to approve the awning sign for the Oasis Lounge at 711 Main Street passed unanimously.

621 Main Street, Independent Goldsmiths – Awning and Identification Signs

Geiger moved and Mattison seconded to approve the awning and identification signs for Independent Goldsmiths at 621 Main Street. In response to a question by Mattison, Cressy explained the awning and identification signs. In response to a question by Geiger, Cressy indicated that the identification sign would be a concrete sign mounted on the brick building. Cressy further indicated that the awning sign will have a diamond logo on the sides of the awning, with the names "Jewelry & Repair", "Galleria", and "Diamonds" along the front side of the awning. The motion to approve the awning and identification signs for Independent Goldsmiths at 621 Main Street passed unanimously.

Minutes

Geiger moved, Mattison seconded, and passed unanimously to approve the minutes of the July 10, 2009 meeting.

Other Business

Roseland stated that downtown business owners have indicated their dislike for the new sign at the former Jerry's House of Pizza at 510 St. Joseph Street. Roseland requested a clarification for the decision of approval for the sign by the Historic Sign Committee. Mattison stated that the face of the sign was changed to accommodate the new business, but the original sign structure is still in place. Geiger identified the function and standards used by the Historic Sign Committee when making decisions on proposed signs in the Historic Districts.

Sign Ordinance Review

Mattison continued the Sign Ordinance review to the August 14, 2009 meeting.
