Mattison called the meeting to order at 8:34 am.

816 South Street – Leo Thomas Salon - Pole Sign

**Kingsbury moved and Jackson seconded to approve the pole sign for Leo Thomas Salon at 816 South Street.** Larson explained the location of the proposed pole sign, north of the sidewalk and out of the site triangles. Larson indicated that the letters on the east side of the sign are changeable letters. Discussion followed on the location of current signage on the building and the location of the pole sign. Mattison indicated that the color blue does not blend the signage on the building. Jackson stated that since the color is away from the building, he does not believe it needs to be the same color. Geiger stated that the blue sign is more visible from the street and although a color that blends with the building is preferable, having the building signs blend with the building is more important. **The motion to approve the pole sign for Leo Thomas Salon at 816 South Street passed unanimously.**
