

Minutes Historic Sign Review Committee January 8, 2010

Blada called the meeting to order at 8:32 am.

523 Sixth Street – Hotel Alex Johnson – 6 Awning Signs

Jackson explained the six signs for the two awnings on the east and south sides of the Hotel Alex Johnson. Roseland moved and Kingsbury seconded to approve the six awning signs for Hotel Alex Johnson at 523 Sixth Street. Jackson stated that the signs will be of wood construction with no lighting. Jackson further indicated that the signs will be located on the front and sides of the two awnings located at the corner of the hotel. The motion to approve the six awning signs for Hotel Alex Johnson at 523 Sixth Street passed with Jackson abstaining.

724 St. Joseph Street - Dennis Daugaard - Wall and 4 Window Signs

Jackson moved and Kingsbury seconded to approve the wall sign and four window signs for Dennis Daugaard at 724 St Joseph Street. Derby stated that the 4 foot x 8 foot wall sign will use a poly vinyl material used for temporary political signs. Derby further indicated that the window signs will have vinyl lettering only and the background material will be eliminated. In response to a question from Kingsbury, Derby stated that the temporary signs will be in place through the June 8, 2010 primary election and possibly the November 2010 election. The motion to approve the wall sign and four window signs for Dennis Daugaard at 724 St Joseph Street passed unanimously.
