

Minutes Historic Sign Review Committee May 28, 2010

Jackson called the meeting to order at 8:35 am.

622 St. Joseph Street – Johnson Creek Antiques – Wall and Pedestrian Signs

Geiger moved and Kingsbury seconded to approve the wall and pedestrian signs for Johnson Creek Antiques at 622 St. Joseph Street. Rutter described the proposed signage to be located at this location. The motion to approve the wall and pedestrian signs for Johnson Creek Antiques at 622 St. Joseph Street passed unanimously.

<u>524 Seventh Street – Swanky Blankie – Wall Sign</u>

Kingsbury moved and Geiger seconded to approve the wall sign for Swanky Blankie at 524 Seventh Street. Musch described the wall sign that will be located on the brick above the glass front. Musch indicated that the sign will be made of plastic material. Jackson indicated that a sign made of wood rather than plastic would be preferable. A call to Budget Signs affirmed that the material was Diebond, a metal sign with vinyl lettering. The motion to approve the wall sign for Swanky Blankie at 524 Seventh Street passed unanimously.

818 St. Joseph Street - Northwestern Mutual - Wall and Pedestrian Signs

Kingsbury moved and Geiger seconded to approve the wall sign and pedestrian signs for Northwestern Mutual at 818 St. Joseph Street. Koehn described the proposed signs and location of the signs on the building. The motion to approve the wall sign and pedestrian signs for Northwestern Mutual at 818 St. Joseph Street passed unanimously.
